**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF

TO THE HONORABLE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Sections 5.71 through 5.74, Wal-Mart Stores East, LP and Sam's East, Inc. (collectively, "Walmart"), hereby file this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, Walmart states as follows:

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3. On April 28, 2016, Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed" or "Company") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") Supplement No. 23 to the Company's Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 52 (the "Filing"), representing a request for a general increase in the Company's electric distribution rates of approximately \$140.2


million, or 9.08% above current rates, to be effective June 27, 2016. This effective date of new rates was suspended until January 27, 2017, by Order of the Commission issued on June 9, 2016.

4. Walmart is a national retailer with 160 facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including a large number of facilities in the Company's service territory. These facilities include Walmart Supercenters, Discount Stores, Sam's Clubs, distribution centers, and gas stations. Walmart takes service from Met-Ed primarily pursuant to Rate Schedule GS-Large, and the cost of electricity comprises a significant portion of the operating costs of Walmart's various retail and distribution locations.

5. The Commission's final determination in this proceeding may directly impact the terms and conditions of the electric service that Walmart receives from the Company. Walmart therefore has a direct, substantial, and unique interest in the outcome of this proceeding that is not represented by any other party. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(2).

WHEREFORE, Wal-Mart Stores East, LP and Sam's East, Inc., requests that the Commission grant this Petition to Intervene and provide Walmart with full party status in this proceeding.
