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PREHEARING MEMORANDUM
OF THE
BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARY D. LONG:

Pursuant to the Prehearing Order dated June 9, 2016, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) respectfully submits the following Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. BACKGROUND

On April 28, 2016, Pennsylvania Power Company (“Penn Power” or “Company”) filed Supplement No. 17 to Penn Power’s Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 36 proposing an annual increase in rates of \$42 million (8.43%).

By Order entered June 9, 2016, the Commission instituted an investigation to determine the lawfulness, justness and reasonableness of the Company’s existing and proposed rates, rules and regulations. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §1308(d), the filing will be

suspended by operation of law on June 27, 2016, until January 27, 2017, unless permitted by Commission Order to become effective at an earlier date.

I&E filed its Notice of Appearance on May 12, 2016.

A telephonic Prehearing Conference is scheduled at 10:00 am on Friday, June 17, 2016, with Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long presiding.
