Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed for filing in the above-captioned consolidated proceedings on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"), Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec"), Pennsylvania Power Company ("Penn Power") and West Penn Power Company ("West Penn") (individually, "Company," and, collectively, "Companies") are the following:

- Met-Ed Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A
- Penelec Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A
- Penn Power Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A
- West Penn Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A

Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A are being filed pursuant to the direct testimony of Richard A. D'Angelo¹ to update Exhibits RAD-66 and RAD-67 for each of the Companies. Exhibits RAD-66 and RAD-67 were included in the initial filing of each Company in compliance with the terms of the Joint Petitions for Partial Settlement of their respective 2014 base rate cases.

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Exhibits RAD-66 and RAD-67 set forth for each Company a comparison of actual expenses and rate base additions for the fully projected future test year in the Companies' 2014 base rate cases (May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016) to the projections employed by the Companies in those cases. At the time the Companies made their initial filings in this case, information about actual expenses and rate base additions was available only through February 29, 2016 and, therefore, Exhibits RAD-66 and 67 contain ten months of actual data and two months of forecasted data. Actual data for March and April 2016 have now become available and, therefore, as Mr. D'Angelo stated the Companies would do, they are submitting their respective Exhibits RAD-66A and 67A, which include actual data for the entire twelve months ending April 30, 2016.

As indicated on the attached Certificate of Service, copies of the enclosed Exhibits RAD-66A and RAD-67A for each Company have been served on the presiding Administrative Law Judge and the parties in the above-captioned consolidated proceedings.

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

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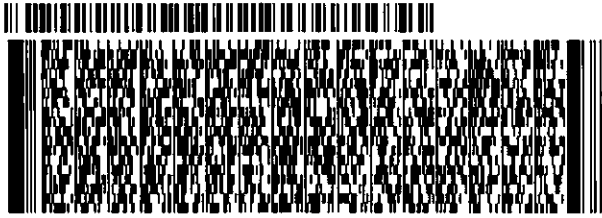
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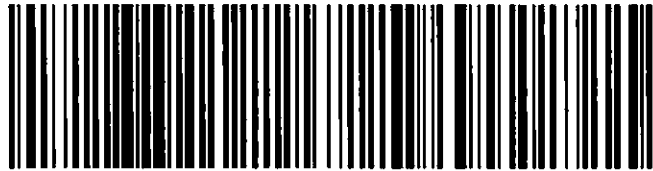
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
