Both Jay Snyder and Fair View Energy, Inc., were listed as defendants in a 2015 matter in the United States District Court of the District of Rhode Island: Frontline Power Solutions, LLC and John T. Holmes v. Jay Snyder and Fair View Energy, Inc., Case No.: 1:15-cv-00411-M-PAS.

Fair View Energy, Inc., as well as all persons identified in this Application, has been or is currently the defendant of a criminal proceeding or any other civil proceeding within the last five (5) years.

The above-referenced lawsuit has been resolved and is now closed. On March 28, 2016, the District Court of Rhode Island, upon the filing of a Stipulation to Voluntarily Dismiss With Prejudice by both parties, ordered the above-reference matter to be dismissed with prejudice.

On May 25, 2016, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") filed a Complaint against Fair View Energy, Inc. with the Commission, alleging unlicensed brokering at Docket No. C-2016-2547502. No complaints have been filed by any customers.

- d. **SUMMARY:** If applicable; provide a statement as to the resolution or present status of any actions listed above.

On June 15, 2016, Fair View Energy, Inc. filed an Answer and New Matter to the Complaint. In the Answer and New Matter, Fair View Energy, Inc. explained that it was unaware of the legal requirement in Pennsylvania for a broker to obtain an electric generation supplier license. Fair View Energy, Inc. also noted that it had ceased engaging in brokering activities requiring an electric generation supplier license and expressed its willingness to file an application. In fact, Fair View Energy, Inc. had already begun the process for filing an application in March 2016 due to concerns raised by the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement during the informal investigation preceding the filing of the Complaint.

On July 5, 2016, I&E filed a Reply to Fair View Energy, Inc.'s New Matter. Currently, this matter is in the discovery phase and awaiting the scheduling of a hearing. Fair View Energy, Inc. plans to engage in settlement discussions with I&E to amicably resolve this matter. Given this pendency of this proceeding, Fair View Energy, Inc. would not oppose a grant of authority to operate as a broker in Pennsylvania, which is conditioned upon the filing of periodic reports or the imposition of other reasonable requirements by the Commission.

Fair View Energy, Inc. will not be taking title to electricity or paying bills on behalf of its clients. An original bond in the amount of \$10,000 is being filed with the Commission separately under seal of confidentiality.

CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.

Sixty days (60) prior to the security instrument's expiration date, Applicant should contact Stephen Jakab at sjakab@pa.gov to determine the appropriate bonding amount based on a percentage of Applicant's gross receipts resulting from the sale of generated electricity consumed in Pennsylvania. Once the amount has been determined, Applicant should overnight the updated security instrument(s) at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date to ensure adequate time for staff review and approval of the security instrument(s).

The founders of Fair View Energy, Inc., Michael P. McCormick and Jay A. Snyder, have extensive experience in the electricity industry.

Michael P. McCormick was Regional Director at Glacial Energy Holdings, Inc. from May 2009 to September 2013. In that role, he recruited sales agents and employees and was responsible for enrolling commercial customers through Glacial, a licensed EGS. He performed similar functions as an independent contractor for Front Line Power Solutions from October 2013 through April 2015.

From August 2010 through March 2011, Jay A. Snyder worked for Glacial as an employee and as an independent contractor, serving as an agent for a broker to enroll commercial customers with Glacial. In 2012 and 2013, he was an account manager at Negawatt. He was later an employee of Front Line, from October 2014 through February 2015, performing similar functions.

Fair View Energy, Inc. is licensed as an electric power broker in Ohio at Case No. 15-1253-EL-AGG (Certificate 15-998E), and as a natural gas broker in Ohio at Case No. 15-1663-GA-AGG (Certificate 15-472G). Copies of the Certificates are included as Attachment 6.

b. STANDARDS OF CONDUCT AND DISCLOSURE: As a condition of receiving a license, Applicant agrees to conform to any Uniform Standards of Conduct and Disclosure as set forth by the Commission. Further, the Applicant agrees that it must comply with and ensure that its employees, agents, representatives, and independent contractors comply with the standards of conduct and disclosure set out in Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 54.43, as well as any future amendments.

AGREED

c. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Applicant agrees to provide the following information to the Commission or the Department of Revenue, as appropriate:

- Retail Electricity Choice Activity Reports: The regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 54.201--54.204 require that all active EGSs report sales activity information. An EGS will file an annual report reporting for customer groups defined by annual usage. Reports must be filed using the appropriate report form that may be obtained from the PUC's Secretary's Bureau or the forms officer, or may be down-loaded from the PUC's internet web site.
- Reports of Gross Receipts: Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
- The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

AGREED

d. TRANSFER OF LICENSE: The Applicant understands that if it plans to transfer its license to another entity, it is required to request authority from the Commission for permission prior to transferring the license. See 66 Pa. C.S. Section 2809(D). Transferee will be required to file the appropriate licensing application.

e. ANNUAL FEES: The Public Utility Code authorizes the PUC to collect an annual fee of \$350 from suppliers, brokers, marketers, and aggregators selling electricity in the Commonwealth of PA, and an annual supplemental fee based on annual gross intrastate revenues, applicable to suppliers only.

See 52 Pa. Code § 54.34.

i. **CEASING OF OPERATIONS:** Applicant is also required to officially notify the Commission if it plans to cease doing business in Pennsylvania, 90 days prior to ceasing operations.
