Please note that selecting this option would make you a formal party to the case and would involve legal proceedings before a PUC administrative law judge. You and the utility would present facts on the issues raised in your complaint. You would then participate in pre-hearing conferences and hearings, respond to questions from the utility, file a written brief to summarize your position and comply with the Commission's procedural rules.
