DEAR Robert/Barbara Stankiewicz:

Recently you contacted the Bureau of Consumer Services about PENELEC (FIRST ENERGY)'s proposed rate increase.

Your objection to the proposed rate increase has been recorded. If you wish to pursue this further, select one of the two options noted below.

- Option 1 - Register a Comment to Proposed Rate Increase - If you wish to register your objection or comment to a proposed rate increase by your utility company, you may fill out a Comment to Proposed Rate Increase Form. Your comments to a proposed rate increase will be placed in the official document folder of the case for review by the presiding officer, the parties to the case and the Commission staff. In addition, a public input hearing may be scheduled in your area to give consumers an opportunity to tell the Commission in person what you think of the proposed rate increase.

OR

- Option 2 - Register a Formal Complaint to a Proposed Rate Increase - If you would like to file a formal complaint against a utility company's proposed rate increase, you may fill out a Formal Complaint to a Proposed Rate Increase Form. **Please note that selecting this option would make you a formal party to the case and would involve legal proceedings before a PUC administrative law judge. You and the utility would present facts on the issues raised in your complaint. You would then participate in pre-hearing conferences and hearings, respond to questions from the utility, file a written brief to summarize your position and comply with the Commission's procedural rules.**
