**STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF JOINT PETITION FOR SETTLEMENT
ON BEHALF OF EXELON GENERATION COMPANY, LLC**

Exelon Generation Company, LLC (“ExGen”) offers this Statement In Support of the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement (“Settlement”) submitted by Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”), the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), the Coalition for Affordable Utility Service and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (“CAUSE-PA”), the Retail Energy Supply Association (“RESA”) and Exelon Generation Company, LLC (“ExGen”) (collectively the “Joint Petitioners”) submitted on September 23, 2016.

ExGen notes that as a party to this proceeding, its interests have generally been unique as compared to those of the other intervenors. ExGen, a wholesale supplier and participant in default service supply auctions, primarily focused its participation on review of the Supplier Master Agreement that contains the terms and conditions that apply when a wholesale supplier wins a procurement opportunity with the electric distribution company (“EDC”), in this case Duquesne. ExGen did not file testimony in this proceeding but did participate in the discovery process. The discovery process provided an opportunity for ExGen to obtain additional clarification of some of the provisions contained in the Supplier Master Agreement. Ultimately, the discovery process led to a clarifying change to the Supplier Master Agreement (adding the Pnode Identifier and delivery point information). *See Rebuttal Testimony of John A. Peoples at*

page 17, line 17 through page 18, line 4, and attached Revised Exhibit JP-6. Moreover, the discovery process also led to the increase of information available to all wholesale suppliers that is contained on the Company's website. *Id.*

ExGen participated in the settlement process and understands that the Settlement represents the give-and-take that occurs between diverse parties agreeing on a broad set of issues and represents a fair outcome to this proceeding. ExGen is particularly supportive of the Settlement because it adopts the default service plans filed by the Company, to which ExGen had no objection. The Settlement also includes the revised pages of the Supplier Master Agreement and a revised transaction confirmation that reflect the pnode identifier and provide all wholesale suppliers with clarification regarding the delivery point for the load procured.

For the reasons, stated above, taken as a whole, the Settlement is in the public interest. ExGen is in support of the Settlement and requests its approval without modification.
