Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On July 25, 2016, Fair View Energy, Inc. ("Fair View") filed the above-captioned application for an electric generation supplier ("EGS") license to operate as a broker/marketer in Pennsylvania. The application was protested by a licensed EGS, Front Line Power Solutions LLC ("Front Line") (Docket No. A-2013-2360865). On August 5, 2016, Fair View filed an answer to the protest pursuant to Section 54.36 of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 54.36. The application was thereafter reassigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge ("OALJ").

Due to the competitive nature of the protest filed by Front Line and the associated delay in the adjudication of the application, Fair View filed a letter on August 26, 2016, requesting the expedited scheduling of a hearing and processing of the application. The OALJ scheduled a hearing for September 26, 2016. Rather than participate in the hearing, Front Line withdrew its protest. By Interim Order dated September 26, 2016, the OALJ therefore cancelled the hearing and transferred the uncontested application to the Bureau of Technical Utility Services.

By this letter, Fair View renews its request for the expedited handling of the application. As the competitive protest has now been withdrawn, Fair View respectfully requests that the Commission adjudicate the application at the public meeting scheduled for October 27, 2016. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
