PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE KATRINA L. DUNDERDALE:

I. INTRODUCTION

Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light" or the "Company") hereby submits this Prehearing Conference Memorandum pursuant to the Prehearing Conference Order issued by the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale (the "ALJ") on October 6, 2016 in the above-referenced proceeding.

On April 15, 2016, Duquesne Light filed its Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan ("LTIIP") with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission"). Therein, the Company explained its proposal for accelerating the repair, improvement and replacement of aging infrastructure for the six-year period beginning January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2022.

On May 5, 2016, the Office of Small Business Advocate ("OSBA") filed a Notice of Appearance.

On May 9, 2016, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") filed a Notice of Appearance.

On May 13, 2016, I&E and the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA") filed Comments in response to the LTIIP.

On May 16, 2016, Citizen Power filed Comments in response to the LTIIP.

On May 26, 2016, Duquesne Light filed its Petition for Approval of a Distribution System Improvement Charge ("DSIC") at the above-captioned docket. Duquesne Light also included the Direct Testimony of three witnesses, Mr. C. James Davis, Mr. John C. Hilderbrand, II and Mr. David B. Ogden, with the DSIC Petition.

On June 15, 2016, I&E filed Answers to Duquesne Light's DSIC Petition.

On September 15, 2016, the Commission issued an Order approving the LTIIP and DSIC. Therein, the Commission referred the following two issues to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and preparation of a Recommended Decision:

- a. DSIC recovery of costs associated with Duquesne Light's Microgrid Property; and
- b. The inclusions of riders in distribution revenues when calculating the DSIC mechanism.

(Order, p. 40.)

On October 6, 2016, the ALJ issued a Prehearing Conference Order setting forth rules for the Prehearing Conference to be held on October 17, 2016.
