OF THE SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interests of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (“Act”). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement setting forth concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the Small Business Advocate’s intervention in the above-captioned Commission proceeding.

On December 8, 2016, NRG Energy, Inc. (“NRG” or “Petitioner”) filed a petition for implementation of electric generation supplier consolidated billing (“Petition”).

The Small Business Advocate is intervening in the above-captioned proceeding in order to protect the interests of Pennsylvania’s small business electric utility customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all of the elements of the Petition is necessary to ensure that it is in the public interest. The Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the proposals and will ask the Commission to deny any requested approvals applicable to

small business customers that are not proven by the Petitioner to be lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory to the Pennsylvania's small business electric utility customers.
