Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Order adopted and entered on January 26, 2017, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved the application of Rasier-PA, LLC (“Rasier”) for a transportation network service license at Docket No. A-2016-2580821. The license issued by the Commission authorized Rasier to transport persons in transportation network service between points in Pennsylvania. This authority to operate granted by the Commission supplants the experimental authority to operate previously provided to Rasier by the Commission at the above-captioned dockets.

As part of its prior experimental authority, Rasier was required to submit on a quarterly basis, compliance reports demonstrating its continued compliance with the conditions and requirements imposed by the Commission in Orders entered on January 29, 2015 and December 5, 2014. Consistent with those Orders, a compliance report would be due on January 31, 2017.


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However, no quarterly compliance reports were required by the Commission as part of its grant of transportation network service authority in the January 26, 2017 Order.

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
