NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGES

To Our Customer:

Pine Roe Natural Gas Company is filing a request with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) to increase your Natural Gas rates as of August 4, 2017. This notice describes the company's rate request, the PUC's role, and what actions you can take.

Pine Roe Natural Gas has requested an overall rate increase of \$50,000 per year. If the company's entire request is approved, the total bill for a residential customer using 2 MCF would increase from \$6.61_to \$31.86_per month or by 381.997%.

To find out your customer class or how the requested increase may affect your Natural Gas bill, contact Pine Roe Natural Gas at (814) 745-3902. You may examine the material filed with the PUC which explains the requested increase and the reasons for it. A copy of this material is kept at Pine Roe Natural Gas Company's office.

The state agency which approves rates for public utilities is the PUC. The PUC will examine the requested rate increase and can prevent existing rates from changing until it investigates and/or holds hearings on the request. The company must prove that the requested rates are reasonable. After examining the evidence, the PUC may grant all, some, or none of the request or may reduce existing rates.

The PUC may change the amount of the rate increase or decrease requested by the utility for each customer class. As a result, the rate charged to you may be different than the rate requested by the company and shown above.

There are three ways to challenge a company's request to change its rates:

1) You can file a formal complaint. If you want a hearing before a judge, you must file a formal complaint. By filing a formal complaint, you assure yourself the opportunity to take part in any hearings convened concerning the rate increase request. All complaints should be filed with the PUC before (proposed effective date of the rate increase). If no formal complaints are filed, the Commission may grant all, some or none of the request without holding a hearing before a judge.

2) You can send the PUC a letter stating your objections to the requested rate increase. Sometimes there is information in these letters that makes us aware of problems with the company's service or management. This information can be helpful when we investigate the rate request.

Send your letter or request for a formal complaint form to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Post Office Box 3265, Harrisburg PA 17105-3265.

3) You can be a witness at a public input hearing. Public input hearings are held if the Commission opens an investigation of the company's rate request and if there is a large number of customers interested in the case. At these hearings you have the opportunity to present your views in person to the PUC judge hearing the case and the company representatives. All testimony given under oath becomes part of the official rate case record. These hearings are held in the service area of the company.

- Operations expense will decrease by \$5,600.00 from the base year, we have been making improvement in the way items are purchased by registering as a utility with some of the vendors we purchase from to make our cost lower. We have also changed cell phone companies and combined all the phones on one bill to lower the monthly costs.
- 2. Maintenance expense will decrease by \$5,000.00 from the base year due to the purchase of some equipment which will make it easier to locate the lines in the system as well as the decrease in automotive insurance.
- 3. Rent will decrease by \$3,000.00 from the base year. We have moved the office to a different location to save on the renting of the office space.
- 4. Salaries are increasing by \$32,415 this increase is to ensure the safety of the customers. We are hiring a full-time field operations manager. This will be Andy Griebel at \$14.00 per hour for a yearly salary of \$29,120. Currently Pine Roe has not had this position filled which is why there were violations. This will also include the salary of a Compliance Office Manager. This will be Pauline Griebel at \$9.35 per hour for a yearly salary of \$17,880.
- 5. Office expenses will decrease by \$3,000, We have found a cheaper place to purchase the letter head paper as well as the envelopes. We are also working on emailing out the bills so that it cuts down on the price of postage as well as paper.
