Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please be advised that the Philadelphia Industrial and Commercial Gas Users Group ("PICGUG") will not be filing Exceptions to the Recommended Decision ("R.D.") of Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Christopher P. Pell and Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl, issued on September 8, 2017, in the above-referenced proceeding.

Nonetheless, PICGUG wishes to clarify two items for the record. First, page 6 of the R.D. indicates that PICGUG only served one piece of surrebuttal testimony ("Surrebuttal Testimony of Michael Ferman, PICGUG Statement No. 3") in this proceeding. In addition to Mr. Ferman's testimony, however, PICGUG served two other pieces of surrebuttal testimony: (1) PICGUG Statement No. 1-SR: Surrebuttal Testimony of Richard A. Baudino; and (2) PICGUG Statement No. 2-SR: Surrebuttal Testimony of Kurt Bresser.

Second, pages 49 and 50 of the R.D. provide "The newly proposed LT service will be available only to new IT load or existing IT customers and will be set at an increment higher than the existing IT rates to recognize that an LT customer will not be subject to potential interruption except in highly unusual circumstances and only with significant notice (the exact rate and the terms and conditions will be determined after meeting with PICGUG and other interested parties)." Although the term "higher" was referenced in Philadelphia Gas Works' ("PGW") Statement in Support and may have been the intent of the parties, PICGUG notes that the language of the Joint Petition for Partial Settlement ("Joint Petition") does not actually contain the word "higher." Joint Petition, ¶ 23(b)(ii) ("The LT rates will be an increment of the IT rates established in this case."). As noted previously, the exact rate and the terms and conditions will be determined after the parties meet to discuss further.
