Upon a joint request of the parties and pursuant to the Interim Order of June 8, 2016, this proceeding was held in abeyance and the case referred to the Commission's Mediation Unit. The parties have engaged in mediation regarding this matter and the matter docketed at A-2015-2466693. To date, mediation has not resulted in a settlement in this proceeding. The Township remains open to possible settlement of the instant matter.

III. PROPOSED SCHEDULE FOR DISCOVERY

The undersigned has conferred with counsel for the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, counsel for Norfolk Southern Railway Company, and Counsel for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. Guilford Township agrees with the proposed

2018, with direct testimony submitted by the end of May 2018, rebuttal testimony in mid-June,

at the Prehearing Conference on March 9, 2018.

Township submits that the costs to construct the same and the cost for future operation and

maintenance should be borne equally by PennDOT and Norfolk Southern Company, or solely by

one or the other of those entities.
