Section A - Rates for Metered Service

1. Customer Charge: Each customer will be assessed a quarterly customer service charge of twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00). (I)

2. Consumption Charge: In addition to the customer charge, the following water consumption charges will apply:

3. Availability Customer Charge: Each availability customer will be assessed a quarterly availability charge of \$20.25. (I)


