Sprint Communications Company L.P.'s Application filed on July 6, 2018 in
the above-referenced docket number stated as follows at page 2, footnote 3:

Sprint Communications has a limited number of enterprise and
wholesale IXC customers, to which it provides private line or data
services pursuant to contract. Sprint Communications notified those
customers in 2016 that they would have to either disconnect service
or transfer to Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services, which
are unregulated by this Commission. Sprint Communications is in the
process of either disconnecting or transferring those final customers
and expects all customers to be transferred by no later than December
2018.

This letter is to notify you that all of the voice IXC customers referenced in
this footnote have now disconnected off of Sprint's TDM network.
