STATUS OF SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS

Dear Administrative Law Judge Haas:

This correspondence is to provide you with a status report on the negotiations in this matter. Delaware Sewer Company ("DSC") has executed an Asset Purchase Agreement with Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC"), and Forest City Partnership, LLC has executed a Land Transfer Agreement with PAWC. However, the parties have been delayed in filing a settlement petition because the plan for improvements required by 66 Pa. C.S. § 529(j), and other related documents, are taking longer than anticipated.

It is requested that the stay of the litigation schedule be extended for an additional ten days (until the close of business on Friday, October 12, 2018) so that the parties may prepare a Joint Petition for Settlement and all accompanying documents resolving this matter. Counsel for PAWC has discussed this request with the other counsel in the case, and they have no objection.
