PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION

Pursuant to the Prehearing Conference Order issued on January 4, 2019, by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Mary D. Long, United States Steel Corporation ("U.S. Steel"), hereby submits this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceedings.

I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On November 13, 2018, Aqua America, Inc. ("Aqua America"), Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Aqua PA"), Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. ("Aqua PA Wastewater"), Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC ("Peoples Natural Gas"), and Peoples Gas Company LLC ("Peoples Gas") (collectively, "Joint Applicants") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") a Joint Application that proposes the acquisition of Peoples Natural Gas and Peoples Gas (collectively, "Peoples Companies") by Aqua America through the purchase of the interests of LDC Funding LLC ("Funding"), the parent company of the Peoples Companies. On

December 21, 2018, U.S. Steel filed a Petition to Intervene to participate in these proceedings. A description of U.S. Steel is set forth in its Petition to Intervene.

III. ANTICIPATED ISSUES

U.S. Steel is still evaluating the Joint Application and anticipates being informed by the record created in these cases. At this preliminary stage, however, U.S. Steel plans to pay careful attention to how the proposed merger may impact the reliability of natural gas delivery, customer service, rates -- including special contract terms -- and the quality of natural gas service that U.S. Steel currently receives, as well as the benefits that the proposed merger may produce for the Joint Applicants and their customers. U.S. Steel anticipates pursuing these issues during these proceedings and reserves the right to raise further issues and to respond to all matters raised by other parties.

IV. PROPOSED WITNESSES AND EVIDENCE

U.S. Steel has not yet received, and therefore has not had the opportunity to review, the Joint Applicants' testimony supporting the Application. As such, U.S. Steel is still in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in these proceedings. In the event U.S. Steel

discerns the need to sponsor testimony, U.S. Steel will promptly inform the ALJ and the parties if

this changes and will identify the applicable witness or witnesses. At present, probable witnesses

for the issues identified above would include Dave Stoner and/or Kylie Zeis, whose business

address is 600 Grant Street, Suite 2014, Pittsburgh, PA, 15219. Regardless, U.S. Steel reserves

the right to participate in these proceedings and adduce evidence through the submission of

discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions,

and reply exceptions, if necessary.

V. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES

The parties in this proceeding, including U.S. Steel, have engaged in initial discussions

regarding the procedural schedule. U.S. Steel will continue to cooperate with the parties and the

ALJ to formulate a reasonable procedural schedule and discovery requirements in accordance with

the Commission's regulations and ALJ directives.

VI. SETTLEMENT

U.S. Steel is willing, and intends, to participate in settlement discussions in this proceeding.
