MOTION OF COMMISSIONER NORMAN J. KENNARD

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for consideration and disposition is the Recommended Decision (RD) of Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) Mark A. Hoyer and Conrad A. Johnson, issued on January 25, 2019, relative to the above-captioned proceedings. The RD recommends approval of a Joint Petition for Settlement (Settlement) regarding the Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority – Water and Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority – Wastewater (collectively, PWSA) proposed water and wastewater tariffs.

In addition to approving the Settlement, the RD sets forth recommended modifications and corrections to PWSA's water and wastewater tariffs. The RD recommends that PWSA file a corrected tariff to address these issues as soon as possible. On January 31, 2019, PWSA filed a Letter with the Commission identifying how it proposes to address each of the additional modifications and corrections set forth in the RD.¹ I agree with PWSA's Letter that the typographical, clarification, and language modifications suggested in the RD should be incorporated into PWSA's Compliance Tariff following the Commission's final order in this matter. I also agree with PWSA that the tariff modifications concerning compliance with specific provisions of the Public Utility Code and the Commission's Regulations would be more appropriately addressed in PWSA's Compliance Plan proceeding now pending at Docket Nos. M-2018-2640802 (Water) and M-2018-2640803 (Wastewater).

¹ In its Letter, PWSA places the modifications and corrections set forth in the RD into three categories, as follows: (1) "typographical stylistic or clarifying corrections," (2) "language modifications," and (3) "directive" for compliance with the Public Utility Code and Commission Regulations.

THEREFORE, I MOVE:

1. That the Joint Petition for Settlement relative to the above-captioned proceeding be adopted in full without modification or correction.
2. That the typographical, clarification, and language modifications set forth in the Recommended Decision be incorporated into PWSA's Compliance Tariff following the Commission's final order in this matter.
3. That the water and wastewater tariff modifications and corrections concerning compliance with specific provisions of the Public Utility Code and the Commission's Regulations be addressed in the Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority's Compliance Plan proceeding now pending at Docket Nos. M-2018-2640802 (Water) and M-2018-2640803 (Wastewater).
4. That the Office of Special Assistants prepare an Opinion and Order consistent with this Motion.
