Re: Application of Sprint Communications Company L.P. for Approval of a General Rule Indirect Change in Control from Softbank Group Corp. to T-Mobile US, Inc., Docket No. A-2018-3003259

Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

Sprint Communications Company L.P.'s Application filed on July 6, 2018 in the above-referenced docket number stated as follows at page 2, footnote 3:

Sprint Communications has a limited number of enterprise and wholesale IXC customers, to which it provides private line or data services pursuant to contract. Sprint Communications notified those customers in 2016 that they would have to either disconnect service or transfer to Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services, which are unregulated by this Commission. Sprint Communications is in the process of either disconnecting or transferring those final customers and expects all customers to be transferred by no later than December 2018.

On September 14, 2018, I filed a letter notifying the Commission that all of the voice IXC customers referenced in this footnote had disconnected off of Sprint's TDM network.

At this time, Sprint Communications Company L.P. does not have any intrastate regulated retail customers left in Pennsylvania as Sprint does not have any remaining voice customers on its TDM network in Pennsylvania. Sprint's remaining retail customers on its TDM network in Pennsylvania are data customers only.



With respect to wholesale, Sprint does not have any intrastate wholesale customers remaining in Pennsylvania. There was one wholesale customer with an intrastate private line when Sprint Communications Company filed its Application, but that customer has since chosen to disconnect its intrastate private line. Sprint does have 2 remaining wholesale customers in Pennsylvania, however, those customers only have a handful of interstate private line circuits remaining.

As indicated in its Application and its discovery responses, based on market conditions, Sprint is transitioning to providing IP only services both nationally and in Pennsylvania.
