Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Section 5.94(a), the Office of Small Business Advocate ("OSBA") withdraws its February 26, 2019, complaint (docketed at C-2019-3008081) against Supplement No. 32 to Tariff Water-Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 ("Supplement No. 32") which was filed on January 11, 2019, by the Buck Hill Water Company ("Buck Hill" or the "Company"). Supplement No. 32, if approved by the Commission, would provide the Company with a general rate increase in water rates of \$106,458 per year.

The OSBA filed its complaint in order to protect the handful of small business commercial customers identified in the Company's January 11th filing.

The OSBA discussed who and what these "commercial" customers are with Company Counsel and Company Management. The OSBA has learned that these "commercial" customers are not, in fact, small businesses in the traditional sense. Instead, they are various non-business entities contained within the Buck Hill grounds. The only outlier is a Federal Post Office customer, which also is contained within the Buck Bill property.

Therefore, Buck Hill does not serve any small business customers, whether commercial or industrial, for the OSBA to represent. The OSBA respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission withdraw the OSBA's February 26th complaint.
