f. Over the last five years (2014-present), PAWC's compliance record at neighboring facilities, specifically the Hershey, Mechanicsburg and West Shore water systems, is as follows:

2014 Notices of Violation:

Hershey - Fish kill that resulted from a main break.

2015 Notices of Violation:

Mechanicsburg and West Shore - DEP inspection violations.

2016 Notices of Violation:

West Shore - Unpermitted discharge after a power outage at the water plant.

2017 Notice of Violation:

Mechanicsburg - Failure to collect a grab sample within four hours after a power outage caused a malfunction of a turbidimeter.

2018 Notices of Violation:

Mechanicsburg - Failure to notify DEP of a main break discharging chlorinated water into a catch basin.

Hershey – Failure to have a certified tank installer repair piping from an above ground storage tank at our Hershey plant.

Hershey – Failure to notify DEP prior to a planned discharge event.

Hershey – Failure to report the monthly low chlorine entry point values.

PAWC's Hershey, Silver Springs and West Shore water systems serve communities located within Cumberland, Dauphin, and Lebanon Counties.
