In compliance with the Secretarial Letter issued in the above-referenced proceeding on January 17, 2019 ("Secretarial Letter"), this correspondence is to inform the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") that Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") has complied with the Secretarial Letter conditions by completing the following:

On April 5, 2019, PAWC filed a Certificate of Service with the Commission that copies of the Application and Amended Application had been served on the parties referenced in the Secretarial Letter.

In compliance with the Secretarial Letter and in compliance with the Final Supplemental Implementation Order entered at Docket No. M-2016-2543193, PAWC advised the Commission on March 8, 2019, that it was beginning to provide individualized notice of the proposed acquisition to all potentially affected PAWC water and wastewater division customers. PAWC has completed providing such individualized customer notice. PAWC has also provided concurrent notice to all current Steelton Borough Authority water customers.

PAWC filed proof of publication of the notice of the proposed acquisition in The Patriot News for two consecutive weeks with the Commission on April 11, 2019.
