To Whom It May Concern:

On September 25, 2018, Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") to acquire the wastewater system of the Township of Exeter ("Township") and to begin wastewater service in the proposed service territory currently served by the Township. By Secretarial Letter dated October 1, 2018, the PUC notified PAWC that the Application was not accepted for filing purposes because, in the opinion of PUC staff, it was incomplete. On December 5, 2018, PAWC filed an Amended Application. By Secretarial Letter dated December 19, 2018, the PUC notified PAWC that the Amended Application was conditionally accepted for filing. By Secretarial Letter dated April 16, 2019, the PUC notified PAWC that the Amended Application was finally accepted for filing purposes.

The PUC Secretarial Letter dated April 16, 2019 directed PAWC to serve a copy of the application on: (i) "each city, borough, town, township, county and related planning office which is included in whole or in part, in the proposed service area"; (ii) "[a] water or wastewater utility, municipal corporation or authority which provides water or wastewater collection, treatment and disposal service to the public and whose service area abuts the service area proposed in the application"; and, (iii) "the Department of Environmental Protection's appropriate regional office."
