
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

At its meeting on July 2, 2019, the East Goshen Township Board of Supervisor unanimously adopted a motion in support of the PUC's proposed amendments to the public utility reporting regulations at Pa. Code §§ 73.1, 73.3, 73.5, and 3.7 providing for annual depreciation reporting, service life study reporting and capital investment reporting and, further, that pipeline operators should be held to the same financial reporting requirements as traditional utilities.

As you know, the Mariner East pipeline project runs the entire length of East Goshen Township, and the project has had a profound impact on the quality of life of the Township's 18,233 resident. We therefore strongly support any and all regulatory efforts to make pipeline operators more accountable to both the Commonwealth and its residents.
