I have been a customer of Pennsylvania American Water (in its many iterations) since 1990. It is bad enough that we pay through the nose for water that has many times throughout these almost 20 years been of questionable quality and that has cost us between two and three times what our neighboring township (actually now the supplier of much of our water) charges their citizens for their municipal water. But now we will be put in the same position with our sewer rates which were raised last year by around 58% and then again, previous to the signing of the Agreement of Sale of the Exeter Township Treatment Plant, by another 28%, with more to come.

It would be nice if just once the PUC voted to protect the citizens of the Commonwealth instead of the corporations. When government colludes with the private sector, the citizens are always the ones to lose and we see that happening once again.
