One of the above-named Supervisors of the Township will be selected at a public meeting of the Board and is expected to testify about the composition of the Township, the Township's physical layout and the communities it serves. The selected Supervisor will discuss the locations of the Mariner East 1 ("ME1") pipeline and/or a work-around 12-inch diameter pipeline that circumvents stopped construction on the Mariner East 2 ("ME2") and Mariner East 2X (ME2X) ("the ME Pipelines") within the Township and its proximities to public gathering, residential and commercial areas. The selected Supervisor is also expected to address the Township's statutory

and constitutionally imposed duties to protect the health, safety and welfare of all who reside and traverse through its boundaries, including practical concerns relating to the Township being within the "blast zone", its past communications and present concerns with Sunoco's production of information and its effect on the Township's ability to engage in effective pre and post-disaster emergency planning.

The selected Supervisor is also expected to testify to the Township's need and desire for an improved system to keep the Supervisors, the Township's Staff and Emergency Planners informed on proper and effective disaster prevention and response and a public education or awareness plan designed to better inform those who live and work near pipelines about what to expect and how to respond in the event of a pipeline emergency. This testimony will include discussion as to response protocols, how they affect the surrounding communities, the advantages for early detection, notification, coordination, responses for special needs populations (such as schools) and education specific to the unique risks posed by the Sunoco Pipelines.

Lastly, the selected Supervisor is expected to testify as to the need and desire for a Remaining Life Study of the ME1 pipeline and why a specific section within the report, to be updated an annual basis so long as the ME1 pipeline remains in Highly Volatile Liquid Service, which addresses the remaining life of the segments of ME1 located within the Township is necessary.
