
Please accept this response from Liberty Power Holdings, LLC ("Liberty Power") to the Comments dated August 27, 2019 by Dan Ocko ("Ocko Comments") regarding the Commission's Opinion and Order entered August 8, 2019 issuing for comment the Joint Settlement Petition ("Joint Settlement") filed on June 6, 2019 in the above-captioned matter. Liberty Power only recently became aware of the Ocko Comments (which were not served on Liberty Power) and offers this brief response to further assist the Commission in its review of the Joint Settlement.

Liberty Power is committed to ensuring that all of its marketing channels operate consistent with legal requirements. Upon request from Commission Staff in August 2019, Liberty Power investigated the same issues identified in the Ocko Comments. Based on this investigation, Liberty Power determined that the telephone number provided by Mr. Ocko was not dialed by any representatives of Liberty Power. Liberty Power also confirmed that the number provided by Mr. Ocko has been removed from all Liberty Power call lists and that the telephone number was added to Liberty Power's internal do not call list. Liberty Power also offered to review the calls received by Mr. Ocko to further investigate his concerns.

The focus of the investigation here, however, is limited (in relevant part) to enrollments submitted to Liberty Power in early 2016 from one specific independent, third-party vendor whose contract with Liberty Power has long been terminated. As such, the unsubstantiated allegations raised in the Ocko Comments do not provide relevant feedback for evaluating the proposed Joint Settlement. Moreover, Mr. Ocko's opinions about the redress that the Commission should take in response to his specific unsubstantiated claims against Liberty Power are not an appropriate basis upon which to disrupt the carefully crafted Settlement Petition presented here.

Therefore, Liberty Power respectfully requests that the Commission consider the proposed Joint Settlement based on the facts, information and analysis included with the Joint Petition and find that the Joint Settlement reasonably addresses the issues raised in this proceeding while also recognizing the proactive measures taken by Liberty Power both before and after initiation of I&E's informal investigation.
