NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE

The Office of Small Business Advocate ("OSBA") files this Notice of Intervention with respect to the Application that was filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") on March 3, 2020 by Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. ("Aqua" or

"Company"), with respect to the proposed (1) approval of Aqua's acquisition of the wastewater assets of the Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority ("DELCORA"); (2) approval of the right of Aqua to begin providing wastewater service in the requested territory; and, (3) inclusion in an order for the ratemaking rate base of the Assets as determined under Section

1329(c)(2) of the Public Utility Code. In support of this Intervention, the OSBA avers as follows:

1. The OSBA is an agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania authorized by the Small Business Advocate Act (Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 – 399.50) to represent the interest of small business customers as a party in proceedings before the Commission.

the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific

interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any

proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission or any other agency or

court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of an

intervention regarding the Application of Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. ("Aqua" or

"Company"), with respect to the proposed (1) approval of Aqua's acquisition of the wastewater

assets of the Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority ("DELCORA"); (2)

approval of the right of Aqua to begin providing wastewater service in the requested territory; and,

(3) inclusion in an order for the ratemaking rate base of the Assets as determined under Section

1329(c)(2) of the Public Utility Code.

The Small Business Advocate has intervened in this case to ensure that the interests of

small business customers served by Aqua, as well as DELCORA are adequately represented.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings

before the Public Utility Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed transaction.

The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny any proposed rate increase or other

changes in the Company's present tariffs that apply to small business customers that are not proven

by the Company to be lawful, just, reasonable and non-discriminatory to all its customer classes.
