Dear Ms. Hilton:

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”),<sup>1</sup> The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (“PWSA” or “Authority”) agreed to formally notify the City of Pittsburgh (“City”) of the Commission’s Order on PWSA’s Compliance Plan Filing proceeding,<sup>2</sup> and that PWSA’s Long Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (“LTIIIP”) Filing.<sup>3</sup>
