Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

We are counsel to Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. ("Aqua") in connection with its above referenced Application for approval of the acquisition of the wastewater system assets of the Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority ("DELCORA"). By letter dated June 11, 2020, the Public Utility Commission conditionally accepted the Application for filing and directed Aqua, *inter alia*, to amend the Application to include a complete copy of the agreement provided as Application Exhibit F103 that includes all the agreement's referenced attachments or provide evidence that this agreement will not be assumed by Aqua.

Application Exhibit F103 is an Agreement, dated May 3, 1966, between the City of Chester and the Borough of Rose Valley addressing the City's receipt and treatment of Borough sewage. As DELCORA now owns both the City of Chester sewer system and the Borough of Rose Valley sewer system, the 1966 Agreement is no longer effective. It will not be assumed by Aqua and is removed from the assigned contracts list.


