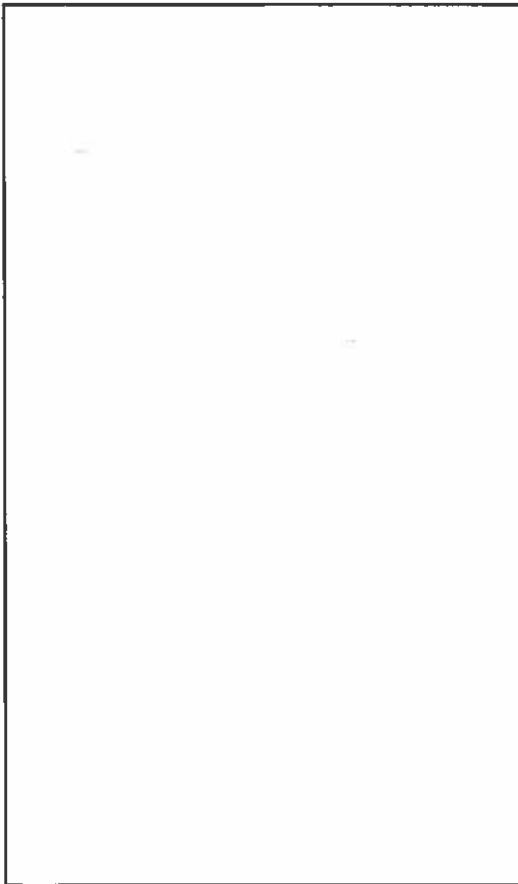

Notice is hereby given that Duquesne Light Company, LLC (Duquesne Light) on August 10, 2020, filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) the Amended Application described above for authorization to rebuild and construct the Brunot Island - Crescent Project ("BI-Crescent Project" or the "Project") in the City of Pittsburgh, McKees Rocks Borough, Kennedy Township, Robinson Township, Moon Township, and Crescent Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. The purpose for the BI-Crescent Project is replace or repair aging transmission infrastructure. The BI-Crescent Project involves the rebuild of the existing double-circuit BI -

Crescent 138 kv Transmission Line that extends approximately 14.5 miles between the Brunot Island Substation in the City of Pittsburgh and the Crescent Substation in Crescent Township. The line will tie into the Montour, Sewickley, and Neville Substations along its route. The Project will maintain Duquesne Light's existing electric transmission capacity at 138 kv.

A telephonic Prehearing Conference upon the Amended Application will be held Friday, September 25, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. All persons or entities that have properly filed a protest or petition to intervene in accordance with Commission regulations may appear and be heard at the Prehearing Conference. The purpose of the Prehearing Conference generally will be to identify the relevant issues and interested parties, if any, and to establish a schedule for the submission of evidence, hearings, and other procedural matters.

If you wish to participate in the process before the Commission, you should file a protest or petition to intervene with the Commission's Secretary. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, employees of the Secretary's Bureau are working remotely and are not accepting filings via U.S. Mail. To establish an e-file account for filing documents at the Commission, follow the steps below:

- (1) Visit www.puc.pa.gov
- (2) Click "Filing & Resources" tab at the top of the page.
- (3) Click "e-Filing" under "Filing and/or Obtaining Information."
- (4) Click "Individual account" hyperlink

(5) Fill out the entire web-based form.

As a reference aid, be sure to include the project's "docket number," which is A-2019-3008589. You also should provide a copy of any protest or petition to intervene to Duquesne Light's counsel and the Presiding Officer by email.
