CSL understands that DELCORA desires to continue with this successful program for another 5 year time period, and as such, CSL is pleased to provide the following proposal for consideration by DELCORA. Under this proposal, CSL would continue to provide exactly the same services as we have been providing under the referenced contract, under exactly the same terms and conditions as the current contract. As with the current contract, CSL proposes to have a Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) made to the current contract unit pricing as listed above on an annual basis beginning in August 2018. This adjustment would be made to the Year 5 unit cost of \$351.23 per meter-month.

CSL, in concert with DELCORA, researched the available COLA indexes for the previous contract. It was mutually determined that the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for Philadelphia-Wilmington-Atlantic City would be the appropriate index to be used for the purpose of cost of living adjustments from contract year to contract year.

Attached is the most recent data available from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (as of April 2018, see attached).
