ADDENDUM NUMBER 1

The purpose of this Addendum is to amend the Existing and Future Sewered Areas Map. The following amendments are made:

1. The area in the extreme eastern portion of Tredyffrin Township known as the Mount Pleasant section and shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.
2. The area in the southwestern portion of East Whiteland Township bounded by Route 29 and Swedesford Road on the north, the 1968-1978 sewered area and Route 352 on the east, the Township line on the south, and the Township line on the west and shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.
3. The area in the southeastern portion of West Whiteland Township bounded by the 1968-1978 sewered area on the north, west, and south and by the Township line on the east and shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.
4. The area in the southerly portion of West Sadsbury Township shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.
5. The area in the easterly portion of Westtown Township in the vicinity of Route 3, Route 352, and Grandview Acres shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.

The area in the central portion of Westtown Township in the vicinity of Oakbourne-Westtown Hillside shown as a sewered area during the 1978-1988 period is changed to be shown as a sewered area during the 1968-1978 period.

These changes to the Existing and Future Sewered Areas Map will necessitate the earlier construction of the appropriate major facilities shown on the Existing and Future Sewerage Facilities Map.

ADDENDUM NUMBER 11

The purpose of this Addendum is to amend the Major Sewage Problem Areas Map. The following areas are added:


1. The Fallowfield Farms area of West Bradford Township.
2. The area surrounding the airport in West Bradford Township.
3. The Wedgewood Park and immediately adjacent area of Westtown Township.
4. The Oakbourne-Westtown Hillside area of Westtown Township.
5. The Grandview Acres area of Westtown Township.
6. The developed area east of Route 352 and south of Route 3 in Westtown Township.

ADDENDUM NUMBER III

The purpose of this Addendum is to amend the text of the report as follows:

1. Page 75, Paragraph 2: Knauertown, Harmonyville, and Unionville are added to the list of villages given in the paragraph.
2. Page 77, Table 12: New London Township, Pennsbury Township, East Marlboro Township, Charlestown Township, North Coventry Township, and Warwick Township are added to the table.

In addition, the entry opposite Westtown Township under "Status of Needed Planning" is changed to read "Partial Feasibility Study Complete".

SEWERAGE PLAN ADDENDUM NUMBER IV

- WHEREAS: The Chester County Planning Commission on December 17, 1968 adopted a County Sewerage Plan upon petition of the municipalities, based upon a plan document prepared by Roy F. Weston, Inc., and,
- WHEREAS: This "County Plan" was approved by all 73 municipalities of Chester County as their "Official Plan" to satisfy the requirements of Pennsylvania Act 537 of 1965; and was subsequently, in 1969 approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, and was incorporated in the metropolitan regional plan adopted December 17, 1969 by the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission, and,
- WHEREAS: Pennsylvania Act 537 and the general planning process recognizes that from time to time plan amendments will be necessary and desirable, and,
- WHEREAS: The Chester County Planning Commission received petitions from the Valley Forge Sewer Authority service area comprised of the East Pikeland, and Schuylkill, and Charlestown Townships; and from the Valley Creek Drainage group comprised of Tredyffrin, East Whiteland, Malvern, and parts of Willistown and Easttown Townships for a plan amendment, and,
- WHEREAS: These petitioners supported by engineering reports and based on several years of intensive negotiations indicated that it is no longer possible, feasible, or desirable for the Valley Forge Sewer Authority municipalities to meet their sewage treatment needs at Phoenixville as proposed on pages 57 and 58 in the discussion of the Phoenixville Regional System; and for the Valley Creek Basin to meet their treatment needs at the Upper Merion Township Plan as proposed on pages 52 and 53 of the Roy F. Weston, Inc., document; and,

SEWERAGE PLAN ADDENDUM NUMBER IV

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
WHEREAS: More recent engineering studies support the petition that regional needs and the objectives of Act 537 can best be met by building a new joint regional plant on the Schuylkill River in Schuylkill Township to serve both drainage areas in lieu of the previous recommendation for treatment facilities at Phoenixville for the Valley Forge Authority, and at Upper Merion Township for the Valley Creek Group.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Chester County Planning Commission does hereby, on April 20, 1970 amend the Chester County Sewerage Plan and recommends that other agencies having jurisdiction similarly approve this plan amendment as follows:

1. Sewage from the areas shown on the maps and discussed on pages 57 and 58 of the Weston report as part of the Phoenixville Regional System be changed to be shown, except for the Borough of Phoenixville, to be treated at a new joint regional treatment plant in Schuylkill Township, on the Schuylkill River, instead of at an expanded Phoenixville Plant.
2. Sewage from the areas shown on pages 52 and 53 of the Weston report as part of the Paoli Area Regional System (Valley Creek Drainage) be changed to be shown to be treated at a new joint regional plant on the Schuylkill River in Schuylkill Township, instead of at Upper Merion Township.
