Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

As counsel for Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. ("Aqua") in the above matter, and as explained further below, we are writing to advise the Commission that Aqua hereby voluntarily extends the six-month statutory consideration period for this proceeding.

This proceeding concerns Aqua's Application under Section 1329 of the Public Utility Code ("Code") for approval of the acquisition of the wastewater system assets of the Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority ("DELCORA") and a determination of ratemaking rate base of \$276,500,000. The Public Utility Commission ("Commission") accepted the Application as complete on July 27, 2020. The Application was formally protested by five municipal entities: the Southwest Delaware County Municipal Authority ("SWDCMA"), the Borough of Edgmont ("Edgmont"), Lower Chichester Township ("Lower Chichester"), the Borough of Upland and the Borough of Trainer. The Application was also protested by two industrial customers of DELCORA. Aqua and DELCORA have resolved through Stipulation each of the municipal protests as well as the Protest of an industrial customer, Kimberly Clark Corporation ("KCC"). Section 1329(d)(2) of the Code requires the Commission to issue a final order within six-months of the filing date of the Application or, in this proceeding, by March 26, 2021.

The County of Delaware ("Delco") has objected to the Stipulations recently filed that advised the Commission of the resolution of the Protests of SWDCMA, Edgmont and Lower

¹ A final Commission order is to be entered 181 days from the date the Application is accepted by the Commission as complete. As the Application was accepted as complete on July 27, 2020, a final order would have been required by January 24, 2021. The Commission, however, by Order entered October 8, 2020, extended the statutory deadline by sixty (60) days to March 26, 2021, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Chichester. Aqua filed an Answer to Delco's Objection to the SWDCMA Joint Stipulation on February 25, 2021. Aqua is filing, later today, Answers in Opposition to Delco's Objections to the Edgmont and Lower Chichester Joint Stipulations.

In consideration of the fact that Notices of Withdrawal of Protests and supporting Joint Stipulations for six Protests have been filed with the Commission *after* the issuance of the Recommended Decision in this proceeding, and furthermore that Objections by Delco and Answers by Aqua to three of those filings have been made with two of Aqua's Answers being filed today, please be advised that Aqua voluntarily extends the six-month statutory consideration period for this proceeding to provide the Commission with additional time to consider these matters.

Extending the six-month consideration period will allow the Commission to take appropriate time, to the extent necessary, to consider the amicable resolution of the interests of the municipal protestants as well as KCC, the withdrawal of their formal protests and the Objections/Answers to those filings. The recently filed Stipulations represent approximately 20% of DELCORA's revenues.
