Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please be advised that the parties to the above-referenced proceeding have resolved all outstanding issues. It is anticipated that the acquisition of substantially all of the wastewater assets of Delaware Sewer Company ("DSC") by Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") will close on or around May 13, 2021.

In order to be in a position to close, the parties are requesting the following Certificates of Public Convenience be issued prior to May 13 evidencing the Public Utility Commission's approval of:

- a. PAWC's acquisition of substantially all of the wastewater system assets of DSC;
- PAWC's acquisition of approximately 140 acres of land from Forest City Partnership, LLC;
- c. PAWC's right to begin providing water service to the public in the Requested Territory, shown in Attachment 1 to Appendix C to the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement of All Issues dated October 12, 2018;
- d. DSC's sale of substantially all of its wastewater system assets to PAWC; and
- e. DSC's abandonment of the provision of wastewater service to the public in Pennsylvania.
