The proposed tariffs contain certain deficiencies that must be addressed by the Applicant before the tariffs can be approved and the Certificate of Public Convenience issued. **The Applicant must submit a copy of this Appendix with its revised compliance tariffs. On that copy, please note the page/sheet of the compliance tariff where the required revision is located for each item below.**

Tariff deficiencies noted – CLEC Local Tariff (A-2021-3028254), Tariff No. 1

1. All Pages: Enter issued and effective dates as per ordering paragraph. Issued date goes on the bottom left of each page, effective date goes on the bottom right.

Response: Issue date of October 15, 2021 is added to bottom left of all pages and effective date of October 18, 2021 is added to bottom right.

2. All Pages: Correct name of Company to “CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC”

Response: Company name has been changed on all pages to CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC.

3. All Pages: Remove and replace reference to “Qwest” throughout the tariff.

Response: Qwest trademark section removed in entirety from Page 5 of Section 1. Other deletions of “Qwest” are resulting from the deletion of services that will not be offered by CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC. Explanation of omissions other than removal of the reference to Qwest are described in more detail elsewhere in this appendix. Miscellaneous references to Qwest removed throughout tariff and services previously identified as offered by Qwest are deleted and replaced with standard services being tariffed throughout this company’s operating territories.

4. Cover Page: Add reference to the ILEC territories and the tariff boundaries that CenturyTel will mirror.

Response: Reference to exchanges served and exchange boundaries is added to Cover Page which is submitted as Supplement No. 1, Page 1). The added reference cites sections elsewhere in the tariff where exchanges and ILEC tariffs are listed.

5. Section 1, Page 1: Correct Application of Tariff. It currently indicates the tariff is for intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

Response: Section 1, Page 1 (Section 1.1) is revised to state the tariff is “applicable to the furnishing of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier services.” The list of ILECs is removed from this page and is replaced with a reference to the section (Section 5.1.1) in which that content appears. This content was duplicated in multiple locations in the illustrative tariff.

6. Section 1, Page 1: Missing ILECs: Frontier Communications of Oswayo River, LLC; Hancock Telephone Company; Hickory Telephone Company; Pennsylvania Telephone Company; TDS Telecom/Sugar Valley Telephone Company; TDS Telecom/Deposit Telephone Company; West Side Telephone Company; Windstream Conestoga, Inc.; Windstream Buffalo Valley, Inc.; Windstream D&E, Inc.; and Yukon Waltz Telephone Company.

Response: The list of ILECs is removed from Section 1, Page 1 and is replaced with a reference to Section 5.1.1 (pages 1 and 2 of Section 5) where the updated list of ILECs includes the above listed companies. In addition, Bentleyville Telephone Company, Marianna and Scenery Hill Telephone Company, and Venus Telephone Corporation are added to those pages.

7. Section, 2, Page 1: Correct definition of “Company.”

Response: Section 2, Page 1 is updated to correct definition of “Company” as follows: “Refers to CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC, the issuer of this Tariff.”

8. Section 6, Pages 6 – 7: The limitations of liability tariff provisions should be generally consistent with the Commission’s relevant Policy Statement at 52 Pa. Code § 69.87 and the Commission Order under Docket No. M-00981209.

Response: The limitations of liability provisions (Section 2.2.3) which appeared in Section 2 on pages 6 and 7 are moved to pages 5 and 6, with no change in section numbering. Proposed language is compliant with the referenced policy statement and docket and is identical to language previously approved for affiliate entity CenturyLink Communications, LLC.

9. Section 5, Page 1: Missing ILECs: Frontier Communications of Oswayo River, LLC; Hancock Telephone Company; Hickory Telephone Company; Pennsylvania Telephone Company; TDS Telecom/Sugar Valley Telephone Company; TDS Telecom/Deposit Telephone Company; West Side Telephone Company; Windstream Conestoga, Inc.; Windstream Buffalo Valley, Inc.; Windstream D&E, Inc.; and Yukon Waltz Telephone Company.

Response: Revised list of ILECs now appear alphabetically in Section 5.1.1 on Pages 1 and 2 of Section 5.

Windstream D&E, Inc. was listed in the illustrative tariff as “Denver & Ephrata Telephone Company.”. References in local calling areas to “Denver & Ephrata” are revised to “Windstream D&E.”

9. *Response (Cont'd)*

Windstream Conestoga, Inc. was listed in the illustrative tariff as “Conestoga Telephone & Telegraph Company.”. References in local calling area column to “Conestoga Tel. and Tel. Co.” are revised to “Windstream Conestoga.” Additionally, the incorrect spelling of Conestoga’s “Topton” exchange in the ILEC Local Calling Areas document is corrected to “Topton” in this filing.

Windstream Buffalo Valley, Inc. was listed in the illustrative tariff as “Buffalo Valley Telephone Company.” References in local calling area column to “Buffalo Valley Tel. Co.” are revised to “Windstream Buffalo Valley.”

Yukon Waltz Telephone Company was listed in the illustrative tariff as “Armstrong Telephone Company.” Exchanges Clinton and Murdocksville which appeared on Page 82 of the illustrative tariff are moved to Page 76, Section 5.1.2.JJ. Those exchanges are not listed in the commission-provided list of ILECs and local calling areas for Yukon Waltz; however, the Murdocksville exchange is listed in the local calling areas of Verizon PA exchanges Burgettstown and Imperial. References to Murdocksville in the local calling area column are updated to “Yukon Waltz.”

Exchanges and local calling areas for additional ILECs which were not included in the illustrative tariff and were not referenced in this Appendix are also added to Section 5.1.2 as follows:

Bentleyville Telephone Company – Page 43

Marianna and Scenery Hill Telephone Company- Page 64

Venus Telephone Corporation – Page 67.

10. Section 5, Pages 2 – 86: Add all Local calling areas for each exchange where the Company plans to provide services. Include all local calling areas for the tariff numbers being revised on the Title Page.

Response: All exchanges and local calling areas now appear in Section 5.1.2 on pages 3 through 76 in the same order as they appear on the above referenced document. Section 5.1.1 contains an alphabetical list of these ILECs.

12. Section 9: Revise language to accurately reflect Pennsylvania Act 12 of 2015. Note the uniform 911 surcharge fee is \$1.65. Please see the following link for additional reference:

Response: The surcharge is added to Page 8 of Section 2 (2.2.4.B.) in the Special Taxes Fees and Surcharges section, for continuity. The TRS Surcharge also appears in this section. General language proposed in Section 9 is compliant with the referenced Act. Due to movement of other content, the 911 language which appeared in Section 9 of the illustrative tariff is moved to Section 8.

Executive Overview (Cont'd)

This filing includes additional revisions from the illustrative tariff as described following:

Title Page: ILECs omitted from illustrative tariff are added.

Section 1.4 – Abbreviations on Page 4 of Section 1 which not relevant to services contained in tariff are omitted.

Section 2.1 - Definitions – definitions not relevant to services being tarified (e.g., Contributory Services, Discount Eligible Service) are omitted. At such time services are introduced that require definitions, this section will be updated when services are introduced. These omissions and other omissions described herein result in the repagination of Section 2.

Section 2.3.6.B. – Termination Liability/Waiver Policy – language on pages 15 and 16 of the illustrative tariff is omitted. The company will not initially offer services which would be subject to this policy. At such time as services are introduced for which this provision would apply, we will tariff.

Section 2.3.7.C. – nonrecurring charge description and rate on page 18 of the illustrative tariff are omitted. Standard nonrecurring charges appear in Section 3.

Section 2.3.8 – Interruption of Service language on Page 19 of the illustrative tariff is replaced with standard language which now appears on page 14. The revised language is being utilized across the company's 20-state service territory.

Section 3 – Service charge section in illustrative tariff is replaced with standardized service charges developed for use across company's 20-state service territory.

Section 5 – Content proposed in Section 6 of the illustrative tariff is moved to Sections 5.3 and 5.4 for consistency and standardization of tariffs across all states in which the company will operate. Section 5.2, Classification of Service is added to page 77 to describe how the company distinguishes business and residence services. Explanation is added to the Connected Voice description on Page 78 to clarify its availability to residence lifeline customers. A standard Flat Rate Basic Line Service is added to Section 5.3.2.

Section 6 – Content appearing in Section 6 of the illustrative tariff is moved to Section 5 and Section 6 is reserved for Local Operator Service. The company does not have a local operator services offering at this time.

Section 7 – Language regarding special promotions and trials which appeared in Section 2.3.5.C. and D. now appear in a dedicated section, with no change in verbiage.

Section 8, Integrated Services Digital Network is omitted. CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC will not offer ISDN at this time and will tariff ISDN if and at such time of a planned offering. Content which appeared in Section 9 of the illustrative tariff is moved to Section 8.

2. General Regulations

2.1 Definitions

Accessories

Devices which are mechanically attached to, or used with, the facilities furnished by the Company and which are independent of, and not electrically, acoustically, or inductively connected to, the communications path of the telecommunications system.

Authorized User

A person, firm, corporation or other entity that either is authorized by the Customer to use local exchange services or is placed in a position by the Customer, either through acts or omissions, to use local exchange services.

Company

Refers to CenturyTel Broadband Services, LLC, the issuer of this Tariff.

Contractual Service Agreement

Each Contractual Service Agreement is an individually negotiated contract offering tailored to meet the telecommunications needs of the Customer(s) for whom the offering was designed. Each Contractual Service Agreement contains a service, or combination of services, and includes supplemental terms and conditions, including without limitation, prices, waivers and alternative pricing structure based upon volume, term, utilization and other needs related to the provision and receipt of telecommunication service(s) under this Tariff: special provisioning flexibility; special network monitoring; special outage credit provisions; special "turnkey" operation; and other specially developed features, functionalities or undertakings. A Contractual Service Agreement may also address or be responsive to special competitive conditions that exist at the time a Contractual Service Agreement is agreed to between the Company and a Customer.

Unless otherwise specifically provided for under each Option set forth in this Tariff, each Option is available to all similarly situated Customers and will be provided pursuant to the identical or substantially similar terms and conditions.

Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Tariff

2. General Regulations

2.1 Definitions (Cont'd)

CPE

Customer-Provided Equipment (CPE) Telecommunication devices, equipment, and associated wiring located on the Customer's side of the protector/Standard Network Interface (SNI).

Customer

Any person, firm, partnership, corporation, municipality, cooperative organization, governmental agency or other entity to whom the Company agrees to furnish communications service under the provisions and regulations of this Tariff.

Deposit

Any payment held as security for future payment or performance to be returned after the Customer establishes a record of satisfactory credit.

Grandfathered Service

Service that is no longer offered to new applicants but may continue for existing Customers who had the service prior to a specific date.

Individual Case Basis (ICB)

A contractual service arrangement in which the regulations, rates and charges are developed based on the specific circumstances of the Customer's situation for a specific service application.

Nonrecurring Charges (NRC)

The one-time charges for services or facilities, including but not limited to charges for construction, installation, administrative or special fees, for which the Customer becomes liable at the time the Service Order is made or executed.

Recurring Charges (MRC)

The monthly charges to the Customer for services, facilities and equipment, which continue for the agreed upon duration of the service.

Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Tariff

2. General Regulations

2.1 Definitions (Cont'd)

Service Address

The service address is the location where the Customer receives the Company provided service.

Service Commencement Date

The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this Tariff, in which case the Service Commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance of service. The parties may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date. A Customer may not unreasonably refuse to accept service.

Standard Network Interface

The point of connection between the Customer and the Company's services which are located at the Customer's premises at a place deemed necessary by the Company in order to insure transmission quality and which is readily accessible to the Customer.

Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP)

Denotes the regulatory, administrative, and operational system developed by the Federal Government to ensure priority provisioning and/or restoration of National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) telecommunications services. The Federal Communications Commission defines NSEP telecommunications services as those services which are used to maintain a state of readiness or to respond to and manage any event or crisis, which causes or could cause harm to the population, damage to or loss of property, or degrades or threatens the NSEP posture of the United States.

Termination Charge

The nonrecurring charge applicable when an agreement for service is terminated by the Customer before the expiration of the minimum agreement period.

2.2 Undertaking of The Company

2.2.1 Scope

- A. The Company does not undertake to transmit messages under this Tariff.
- B. The Company shall be responsible only for the installation, operation and maintenance of the services, which it provides.
- C. The Company will, for maintenance purposes, test its services only to the extent necessary to detect and/or clear troubles.
- D. Services are provided 24 hours daily, seven days per week, except as set forth in other applicable sections of this Tariff.
- E. The Company does not warrant that its facilities and services meet standards other than those established for the service.

2.2.2 Limitations

- A. Services are offered subject to the availability of facilities and the provisions of this Tariff.
- B. The customer may not assign or transfer the use of services provided under this Tariff without the prior written consent of the Company.
- C. The customer may not, nor may the customer permit others to, rearrange, disconnect, remove, attempt to repair or otherwise interfere with any of the facilities or equipment installed by the Company, except upon written consent of the Company.

2.2.3 Liability of The Company

- A. The Company shall be indemnified and held harmless by any subscriber, user or by any other entity against claims for libel, slander or the infringement of copyright arising from the material transmitted over its services; and against all other claims arising out of any act or omission of a subscriber or of any other entity in connection with the services provided by the Company.
- B. The Company is not liable for any act or omission of any entity furnishing facilities or services connected with or provided in conjunction with the services of the Company.
- C. The Company shall not be liable for any personal injury, or death of any person or person, and for any loss or damage sustained by reason of acts, mistakes, omissions, errors or defects in providing its services, whatever shall be the cause which is not the direct result of the Company's gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- D. Except as otherwise provided herein, no liability for indirect, incidental or consequential damages shall attach to the Company, its agents, servants or employees, for damages or costs arising from errors, mistakes, omissions, interruptions, failures, delays, or defects or malfunctions of equipment or facilities, in the course of establishing, furnishing, maintaining, rearranging, moving, terminating, or changing the service or facilities (including the obtaining or furnishing of information in respect thereof or with respect to the Customer or users of the service or facilities) in the absence of willful and wanton conduct or gross negligence, whether a claim for such liability is premised upon breach of contract, breach of warranty, fulfillment of warranty, negligence, strict liability, misrepresentation, fraud, or any other theories of liability.
- E. The Company shall not be liable for any failure of performance due to causes beyond its control, including, without limitation, acts of God, fires, floods or other catastrophes, national emergencies, insurrections, riots or wars, strikes, lockouts, work stoppage or other labor difficulties, acts or omissions of other telecommunications carriers or service providers, and any law, order, regulation or other action of any governing authority or agency thereof.

2.2.3 Liability of The Company (Cont'd)

- F. The Company shall not be liable to a Customer or service user or any other person, firm, entity, for any failure to perform its obligations under this Tariff due to any cause or causes beyond its reasonable control, which is not the direct result of the Company's gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- G. The remedies set forth herein shall not be exclusive and the Company at all times shall be entitled to all rights available to it under either law or equity.
- H. Customer will defend and indemnify the Company, its affiliates, agents and contractors from all third party claims and liabilities arising from or related to customer's, customer's end user's or customer's third-party provider(s)' acts, omissions (including the failure to purchase or implement features that enable the receipt and transmission of direct-dial "911" calls or multi-line telephone system notifications), or failures of connectivity that impede, prevent or otherwise make inoperable the ability of the customer or its end users to directly dial "911" or to receive or transmit multi-line telephone system notifications, as required by law, in the United States.
- I. Customer will defend and indemnify the Company, its affiliates, agents and contractors from all third party claims and liabilities arising from or related to any acts or omissions by the customer, customer's end users or customer's third-party provider(s) that cause, give rise to or bring about the non-compliance of the service with any applicable law, including the failure to purchase or implement features that enable compliance with laws.

2.2.4 Special Taxes, Fees, Surcharges

Any sales, use, privilege, excise, franchise or occupation tax, costs of furnishing service without charge or similar taxes or impositions now or hereafter levied by the Federal, State, or Local government or any political subdivision or taxing authority thereof may be billed by the Company to its local exchange Customers on a pro rata basis in the areas wherein such taxes, impositions or other charges shall be levied against the Company, or may require collection of such taxes, fees and charges by the Company.

A. Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) Surcharge

1. General

The Pennsylvania Telecommunications Relay Service (PA TRS) is a relay telecommunication service for the deaf, hard of hearing, hearing and/or speech disabled population of the Commonwealth. The PA TRS is mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide functionally equivalent telephone services that are available to other U.S. citizens, at no additional cost. The PA TRS includes both traditional relay (devices such as Teletypewriters (TTY) and Telecommunication Devices for the Deaf (TDD)) and captioned-telephone voice-carry-over relay services (captioned telephone). These relay services permit telephone communications between individuals with hearing and/or speech disabilities, who must use a TTY, TDD or captioned telephone, with individuals having normal hearing and speech. Additionally, 711 abbreviated dialing is available to access the PA TRS. The Company's switching equipment is arranged to translate the "711" calls to the assigned toll-free number, (888) 895-1197, in order to route calls to the Telecommunications Relay Service Provider, in accordance with Commission's Order entered on February 4, 2000 at Docket No. M-00900239.

Local calls will be charged at the applicable local flat rate or local measured service rate. Toll calls will be charged at the applicable toll rate found in the selected long distance provider's rate schedule or current tariff. If the customer has not chosen a long distance carrier the default carrier's rates will apply for the toll calls.

2.2.4 Special Taxes, Fees, Surcharges

A. Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) Surcharge (Cont'd)

2. Surcharge

In addition to the charges provided in this tariff, a surcharge will apply to all residence and business access lines served by this Company. (Access lines are those lines extending from the telephone company's central office to the end-user's premises.) This surcharge applies regardless of whether or not the access line uses the PA TRS.

The surcharge serves as the funding vehicle for the operation of the PA TRS, Telecommunications Device Distribution Program and the Print Media Access Service Program and shall be calculated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the Commission). The Commission shall compute the PA TRS surcharge each year and notify local exchange carriers of the surcharge amount to be applied for the twelve-month period commencing with July 1 of each year.

The Commission may revise the surcharge more frequently than annually at its discretion.

Tariff revisions will be filed whenever the Commission calculates a new surcharge amount and notifies the Company.

B. 911 Surcharge

1. General

Pennsylvania Act 12 of 2015 (Act 12) amended the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act by authorizing a 911 surcharge on each subscriber or consumer for each 911 communications service. Pursuant to Act 12, the Company will collect a 911 Surcharge from its customers to support the 911 system.

2.3 Establishing and Furnishing Service

2.3.1 Application for Service

A. Refusal

The Company reserves the right to refuse an application for service made by a present or former Customer who is indebted to the Company for service previously furnished, until the indebtedness is satisfied. The Company may refuse to furnish or may deny service to any person, business or entity on whose premises exists any telecommunications related facility which shows any evidence of tampering, manipulating, or operation, or use of any device whatsoever, for the purpose of obtaining service without payment of the charges applicable to the service rendered. The Company may refuse to offer service where, in the Company's judgment, a service cannot reasonably be made available to a Customer.

B. Cancellations and Deferments

When the Company advises a Customer that ordered services are available on the requested due date, and the Customer is unable or unwilling to accept service at that time, the facilities will be held available for the Customer for a 30 calendar day grace period. If after 30 calendar days the Customer still has not accepted service, the Customer will be contacted and regular monthly billing for the ordered service shall begin if the Customer requests that facilities continue to be held for their future use. Otherwise, the facilities will be released for other service order activity, and cancellation charges (non-recurring charges that would have applied had the service been installed) shall be applied.

C. Use of Service

1. Limitation on Use

Service is furnished to the Customer for use only by the Customer or by employees or representatives of the Customer or by other users authorized by the Customer.

When the general service to the public is impaired or in the Company's opinion is reasonably likely to be impaired by a Customer's use of exchange service, the Company shall have the right to require the Customer to contract for and properly maintain as many additional access lines as are needed to adequately serve the Customer's requirements, or to discontinue the service of the Customer in question.

2.3 Establishing and Furnishing Service (Cont'd)

2.3.2 Obligation to Furnish Service

- A. Facilities and lines furnished by or through the Company on the premises of a Customer, authorized user or agent of the Customer are the property of the Company and are provided upon the condition that such facilities and lines must be installed, relocated, rearranged and maintained by the Company, and that the Company's employees and agents may enter said premises at any reasonable hour to test and inspect such facilities and lines in connection with such purposes, or upon termination or cancellation of the service, to remove such facilities and lines.
- B. The Company's Obligation to Furnish Service or to continue to furnish service is dependent on its ability to obtain, retain and maintain suitable rights and facilities, and to provide for the installation of those facilities required incident to the furnishing and maintenance of that service.
- C. The Company's Obligation to Furnish Service or to continue to furnish service is dependent on the Customer's prompt payment record with the Company and its actual payments for existing service. For a new Customer, it is based on credit worthiness, which will be determined in an equitable and nondiscriminatory manner.

2.3.3 Limited Communication

The Company reserves the right to limit use of communication services when emergency conditions cause a shortage of facilities.

2.3.4 Payment Arrangements

The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services furnished by the Company to the Customer and/or authorized users. This responsibility is not changed by virtue of any use, misuse, or abuse of the Customer's service or Customer-provided equipment or facilities by third parties, including, without limitation, the Customer's employees or the public.

2.3.5 Special Services

A. Work On Customer's Premises

It is contemplated that all work on Customers' premises can be performed during regular working hours. If a Customer requests that work be performed during hours which results in overtime or premium rates of pay, a charge may apply in addition to other rates and charges which may be applicable, based on the amount of overtime or premium time required, as determined on an individual case basis.

It is also contemplated that all installation, removals, service connections, moves and changes requested by a Customer be performed without the Company incurring unusual costs. If a Customer requests that work be performed in a special manner or at a special time which results in unusual costs, a charge equal to the amount of unusual costs may apply in addition to other applicable rates and charges, as determined on an individual case basis.

The Company will provide a cost estimate to the customer and obtain customer approval prior to performing work that entails overtime or premium rates or unusual costs.

B. Special Arrangements

1. The rates and charges quoted in this Tariff contemplate the use of standard arrangements, that is, the arrangement normally used by the Company to provide the type of service involved.
2. For special service arrangements to be provided by this Company, and not specifically covered in this Tariff, including but not limited to services, features, and combinations of services and features not normally offered or combined, monthly rates and the one-time charges, such as installation, nonrecurring and construction charges will apply based on the circumstances in each case. To the extent that a service is not normally offered in this tariff, the price, terms and conditions will be described in the contract.

2.3.5 Special Services

B. Special Arrangements (Cont'd)

3. These special equipment and service items will be provided whenever, in the judgment of the Company, there is a valid business reason for providing the service requested. In such cases, the Company reserves the right to require an initial contract period longer than one (1) month at the same location.
4. The rates, terms and conditions for these Special Arrangements offerings will be established on an individual case basis.

C. Individual Case Basis (ICB)

In lieu of the rates otherwise set forth in this Tariff, rates and charges including installation, special construction and recurring charges for Company services may be established at negotiated rates on an ICB, taking into account the nature of the facilities and services, the costs of construction and operation, and the length of service commitment by the customer. Such arrangements shall be considered special pricing arrangements, the terms of which will be set forth in individual contracts. Special pricing arrangement rates or charges will be made available to similarly situated customers on equal terms and conditions.

2.3.6 Termination of Service

A. Initial Service Periods

1. The initial service period for service and facilities is one month (30 days), except as otherwise specified.
2. Initial service periods for service or facilities of any class will be greater than those specified herein whenever that is required in order for the Company to protect itself from making an unwarranted investment because the Customer's location or the character of the service required is such that upon termination of the Customer's contract the facilities which have been constructed or installed to render the service are not likely to be useful for furnishing service to any other Customer.
3. Service may be terminated prior to the expiration of the initial service period upon payment of all charges due for service which has been furnished plus the termination charges as specified in this Tariff, or in the terms of the service agreement. In the case of service for which the initial period is one month, the charges due are for the balance of the month.

2.3 Establishing and Furnishing Service (Cont'd)

2.3.7 Termination of Service – Company Initiated

- A. The Company may suspend service under the following conditions provided that, unless otherwise stated, the customer shall be given seven (7) days written notice to comply with any rule or remedy any deficiency:
1. For nonpayment of an undisputed delinquent account or the undisputed portion of an account where a dispute exists as to part but not all of an amount billed by the Company.
 2. For failure to make a deposit as security for payment of future bills, the failure to provide a guarantee or establish credit, or the failure to comply with the material terms of a payment agreement.
 3. For use of telephone service for any property or purpose other than that described in the application.
 4. In the event of abandonment of the service or any other violation by the customer of the rules, regulations or conditions under which service is furnished.
 5. Fraud or material misrepresentation of identity to obtain telephone service.
 6. Unpaid indebtedness for telephone service previously furnished by the Company in the name of the customer within four (4) years of the date the bill is rendered.
 7. In the event of unauthorized or fraudulent use of service.
 8. Without notice, when the use of the service by a customer endangers the safety of a person or appears likely to prove physically harmful to the service delivery system of the Company. At the time of suspension, the Company will mail a notice of suspension to the customer's billing address.
- B. When at least ten (10) days have passed since suspension of service, the Company may terminate service for failure to pay a reconnection fee and to remedy the original grounds for suspension due to any of the following reasons: 1) failure to make satisfactory arrangements to pay arrearages; 2) failure to post a deposit, furnish a third-party guarantee or otherwise establish credit; 3) failure to meet the requirements of a payment agreement; or 4) failure to give adequate assurances that an unauthorized use or practice will cease.

2.3 Establishing and Furnishing Service (Cont'd)

2.3.8 Interruption of Service

- A. After an interruption or outage of local service of more than 24 hours, the Company shall refund a portion of the monthly charge for the number of days without service.
- B. For calculating credit allowances, every month is considered to have 30 days. A credit allowance for fixed recurring fees only is applied on a pro rata basis against the rates specified hereunder and is dependent upon the length of the interruption. Only those facilities on the interrupted portion of the circuit will receive a credit.
- C. An interruption period begins when the Customer reports a service, facility, or circuit to be interrupted and releases it for testing and repair. An interruption period ends when the service, facility, or circuit is operative. If the Customer reports a service, facility, or circuit to be inoperative but declines to release it for testing and repair, it is considered to be impaired, but not interrupted.
- D. Exceptions to Credit Allowance

The allowance described preceding is not applicable and no credit allowance will be made for:

- interruptions due to the negligence of, or noncompliance with the provisions of this Tariff by, the Customer, authorized user, joint user, or other common carrier providing service connected to the service of the Company;
- interruptions due to the negligence of any person other than the Company, including but not limited to the Customer or other common carriers connected to the Company's facilities;
- interruptions due to the failure or malfunction of non-Company equipment;
- interruptions of service during any period in which the Company is not given full and free access to its facilities and equipment for the purpose of investigating and correcting interruptions;
- interruptions of service during a period in which the Customer continues to use the service on an impaired basis;
- interruptions of service during any period when the Customer has released service to the Company for maintenance purposes or for implementation of a Customer order for a change in service arrangements; or
- interruption of service due to circumstances or causes beyond the control of Company.

2.4 Payment for Service

2.4.1 Customer Responsibility

A. The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for facilities and services furnished to the Customer, including charges for services originated, terminated, or accepted, at such facilities.

B. Multi-Line Telephone Systems

1. Pursuant to 47 CFR §9.16(b)(1) and (2), multi-line telephone systems connected to the Company's network which were manufactured, imported, sold, leased, or installed after February 16, 2020 must be configured to:

- allow an end user to directly initiate a "911" call from any station equipped with dialing facilities, without dialing any additional digit, code, prefix, or post-fix, including any trunk-access code such as the digit 9, regardless of whether the user is required to dial such a digit, code, prefix, or post-fix for other calls, and
- provide MLTS notification to a central location at the facility where the system is installed or to another person or organization regardless of location, if the system is able to be configured to provide the notification without an improvement to the hardware or software of the system.

MLTS notification must (1) be initiated contemporaneously with the 911 call, provided that it is technically feasible to do so; (2) not delay the call to 911; and (3) be sent to a location where someone is likely to see or hear it.

Customers who connect multi-line telephone systems to the Company's facilities must agree to defend and indemnify the Company for acts and omissions resulting in non-compliance, as described in Section 2.2.3.H.

2.4.1 Customer Responsibility

B. Multi-Line Telephone Systems (Cont'd)

2. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 9.16(b)(3), a person engaged in the business of installing MLTS may not install such a system in the United States unless it is configured such that it is capable of being programmed with and conveying the dispatchable location of the caller, as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3, to the PSAP with 911 calls consistent with the requirements below. A person engaged in the business of managing or operating MLTS may not manage or operate such a system in the United States unless it is configured such that the dispatchable location of the caller, as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3, is conveyed to the PSAP with 911 calls consistent with the following requirements:
 - On-premises fixed telephones associated with a MLTS must provide dispatchable location by January 6, 2021;
 - No later than January 6, 2022, on-premises non-fixed telephones associated with a MLTS must provide dispatchable location where technically feasible, otherwise they shall provide dispatchable location based on end user manual update or on alternative location information as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3;
 - No later than January 6, 2022, off-premises non-fixed telephones associated with a MLTS must provide dispatchable location where technically feasible, otherwise they shall provide dispatchable location based on end user manual update, or enhanced location information which may be coordinate based and consisting of the best available location that can be obtained from any available technology or combination of technologies at reasonable cost.

2.4.1 Customer Responsibility

B. Multi-Line Telephone Systems

2. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 9.16(b)(3)...the following requirements: (Cont'd)

- Additionally, providers of fixed telephony services shall provide automated dispatchable location with 911 calls beginning January 6, 2021 pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 9.8. Providers of interconnected VoIP service must comply with the location requirements under 47 C.F.R. § 9.11(b)(iv) for non-fixed services as of January 6, 2022. Customers to DID Service capable of accessing 911 emergency services shall be responsible for providing automated dispatchable location information as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3 and for maintaining the accuracy of that information for fixed services as of January 6, 2021 and for non-fixed services where technically feasible as of January 6, 2022.
- Customers, particularly private switch owners, private branch exchange owners, and customers of DID service, may need to purchase additional features or services to comply with the dispatchable location provisions of RAY BAUM's Act. Dispatchable location capability may require Customers to purchase private switch automatic location identification (PS/ALI) service from the Company or from a third-party provider.

Customers who connect multi-line telephone systems to the Company's facilities must agree to defend and indemnify the Company for acts and omissions resulting in non-compliance, as described in Section 2.2.3.I.

2.4 Payment for Service

2.4.2 Payment of Bills

A. Charges Due

Charges for local exchange service and facilities are billed in advance. Payment is due as required by statute or state administrative rules. All bills are payable by any means mutually acceptable to the Customer and the Company. Failure to receive a bill does not exempt the Customer from prompt payment of their account. The Customer is held responsible for all charges for local exchange service and facilities furnished at the Customer's request.

The Company shall utilize credit policies and reasonable and equitable methods in its debt collection practices as specified by state and federal government regulations.

B. Returned Payment Charge

A returned payment charge in the amount of \$25, or a lesser amount as permitted by state rule or law, may apply to the Customer's account for each occasion that a check, bank draft, or an electronic funds transfer item is returned to the Company for the reason for insufficient funds or no account.

C. Late Payment Charge

1. Billing will be payable upon receipt. The date of payment is the date the payment is received by the Company. Amounts not paid within 30 days after the invoice is rendered will be considered past due. A late payment charge at the rate of 1.5% per month (unless a lower rate is prescribed by law, in which event at the highest rate allowed by law) may accrue upon any unpaid amount commencing five days after the date the payment is past due. When billing is provided by a local exchange company on behalf of the Company, the local exchange company's late payment charge applies to all past due amounts, if applicable.
2. Collection procedures, temporary disconnection of service, and the requirements for deposit are unaffected by the application of a late payment charge.

D. Notice of Suspension

In the event it becomes necessary for service to be discontinued to a Customer for nonpayment, a written notice, mailed or delivered no sooner than five (5) days following the original due date of the bill, will be given advising the Customer of the amount due and the date by which the same must be paid. If the Customer fails to pay or make suitable arrangements for payment by said due date, the Company may suspend the service or discontinue the service and remove any or all of its equipment from the Customer's premises.

2.4 Payment for Service (Cont'd)

2.4.3 Customer Deposits and Advance Payments

A. Deposits From Applicants for Service and Present Customers

1. Any applicant or Customer whose financial responsibility is not established to the satisfaction of the Company may be required to provide a deposit to the Company, pursuant to the provisions in state rules. The deposit will bear interest at a rate required or allowed by state laws or regulations.
2. The payment of a deposit shall in no way relieve the applicant or Customer from complying with the Tariff rules and regulations for the prompt payment of bills on presentation.

B. Advance Payment

To safeguard its interests, the Company may require the Customer to make an advance payment before services and facilities are furnished. in the following cases: 1) the construction of facilities and furnishing of special equipment, or 2) temporary service for short-term use. The advance payment will not exceed an amount equal to the nonrecurring charge(s) and one month's charges for the service or facility. In addition, where special construction is involved, the advance payment may also include an amount equal to the estimated nonrecurring charges for the special construction. The advance payment will be credited to the customer's initial bill. An advance payment may be required in addition to a deposit.

2.4.4. Billing Disputes

The customer is responsible for notifying the Company of any charges in dispute and the specific basis of such dispute. All charges not in dispute shall be paid by the customer by the payment due date. Upon notification of a dispute, the Company shall undertake an investigation of the disputed charges. At the conclusion of the investigation, the Company shall notify the customer of any amount determined by the Company to be correctly charged and such amount shall become immediately due and owing. Amounts determined by the Company to be correctly charged shall also be subject to the late payment charge specified in this Tariff. 3. Service Charges

3.1 Nonrecurring Charges

3.1.1 Description

A nonrecurring charge is a one-time charge associated with a given service or item of equipment made under certain conditions to customer-initiated requests to install, move, or change telephone service.

Service-specific nonrecurring charges found in other sections of this tariff may also apply in addition to, or in lieu of, the charges specified in this section.

Nonrecurring charges for resold services may be priced according to the Nonrecurring charges established for such Services in the underlying carrier's effective intrastate tariff, price list, local terms of service, rate schedule or guide book.

3.1.2 Terms and Conditions

A. Service Charges apply as follows:

1. A Service Implementation Charge applies:

- to new service orders,
- to orders to move telephone service from one location, address, suite, or premise, to another,
- for the re-establishment of service and facilities suspended because of nonpayment of bills and is payable at the time that the re-establishment of the service and facilities suspended is arranged for (restoration of service) and
- when, after disconnection of service, service is later re-established.

- to establish or change billing name responsibility subsequent to the initial installation of service (change of responsibility),
- for change of telephone number initiated by customer; and
- any other customer-initiated record change that does not include a change in service unless otherwise specified in 3.1.2.B. following.

B. Service Charges do not apply to:

- Move or change a customer's telephone service if required or initiated by the Company.
- Install, move, or change telephone service located on a customer's premises but used exclusively by the Company for maintenance or training activities.
- The "from" portion of work involved in a transfer of service from one premises to another.
- Change a customer's mailing address.
- Move a drop for Company initiated maintenance reasons.

C. A Premises Visit Charge applies in addition to the applicable Service Charge when a Company representative must visit the customer's premises in order to establish service or to complete a customer-requested change.

D. A Trouble Isolation Charge (a.k.a. Maintenance of Service Charge) applies when the Company dispatches a technician to investigate a customer-reported trouble and a service difficulty is found to be caused by customer-provided equipment, wire, facilities, communications system or customer actions, and the customer does not have the Company repair the premises wire trouble.

The Trouble Isolation Charge also applies when a customer requests or allows the Company to dispatch a technician to investigate the reported trouble and the customer then does not allow access to the necessary in-home wiring and equipment or is not available to allow access. This charge is waived for customers who have inside wire protection, unless the Company determines through remote testing that no trouble exists, and the customer insists on a dispatch. If no trouble is found, a Trouble Isolation Charge applies whether or not the customer has inside wire protection.

E. The Trouble Isolation Charge will not apply when:

- Customer is subscribed to an Inside Wire Maintenance Plan before a Company technician is dispatched
- A service difficulty or trouble is found to be in a permanently wired telephone associated with service (i.e., no network interface device)
- The service difficulty or trouble is in Company-maintained equipment or wiring.
- No trouble is found after customer allows the necessary access to in-home wiring and/or equipment.
- Customer authorizes company repair of inside wiring and/or customer-provided equipment

F. Duplicate Bill Charge

In the event a customer requests a reprint of a monthly bill that is greater than six months old, a duplicate bill charge may apply. When billing is provided by a local exchange company on behalf of the Company, the local exchange company's duplicate bill policy applies.

5.2 Classification of Service

The determination as to whether telephone service should be classified as Business or Residential is based on the character of the use to be made of the service. Service is classified as Business service where the use is primarily or substantially of a business, professional, institutional, or otherwise occupational nature. Where the business use, if any, is incidental and where the major use is of a personal or domestic nature at the person's dwelling, service is classified as Residential service.

5.2.1 Business Classification

Classification of Business rates apply at the following locations, among others:

- In offices, stores and factories, and in quarters occupied by clubs, lodges, fraternal societies, schools, colleges, libraries, hospitals, and other business establishments.
- In residence locations where the place of residence is in the immediate proximity to a place of business and it is evident that the telephone in the residence is or will be used for business purposes, and in residence locations where an extension is located at a place where business rates would apply.
- In the residence of a practicing physician, dentist, veterinary, surgeon, or other medical practitioner who has no service at business rates at another location.
- In any residence location where there is substantial business use of the service, and the customer has no service at business rates.

5.2.2 Residence Classification

Residence rates apply at the following locations, among others:

- In private residences; in the residential portion of hotels, apartment houses, boardinghouses, churches, or institutions when the use of the service is confined to the domestic use of the customer and listings of a business nature are not furnished.
- In the residence of a practicing physician, dentist, veterinarian, surgeon, or other medical practitioner provided that such residence is not a part of an office building and provided the customer has service charged for at business rates another location.

Local exchange services are provided subject to availability of facilities and technical resources. Resold features and services associated with resold Local Exchange Service may be priced according to the rates established for such features in the underlying carrier's effective intrastate and interstate tariffs, unless specified otherwise herein. Such charges may include, but are not limited to interstate and/or intrastate end user charges such as subscriber line charge, access recovery charge, line port charges, etc.)

5.3.1 Connected Voice

A. Description

1. Connected Voice is a VoIP (Voice over Internet Protocol) service available to single line residence customers who are enrolled in the Federal Lifeline Assistance Program described in Section 5.4.1.B. Connected Voice provides inbound calling and unlimited local and domestic long distance direct-dialed outbound calling utilizing an Internet Protocol (IP) to IP or Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN) to IP (or vice-versa) hand-off and which Customer certifies to Company is either originated by Subscribers in or terminated to Subscribers via an IP format (or is otherwise enhanced traffic). Company will route calls to the PSTN or an IP address and terminate them to a Customer Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) Application. The following calling features are included:

- Caller Identification
- Three-Way Calling
- Anonymous Call Block
- Call Forwarding
- Call Waiting/Cancel Call Waiting
- Call Hold
- Do Not Disturb (block all calls)

2. Internet or data connectivity and compatible analog or digital phones are required.
3. Connect Voice is offered for a minimum service term of one month.
4. Should a customer be deemed ineligible for Federal Lifeline Assistance, the customer may subscribe to other tariffed services offered by the Company.”
5. Charges in this section for Connected Voice are in lieu of any other monthly and/or nonrecurring charges found elsewhere in this tariff.

5.3.2 Flat Rate Basic Line Service

A. Description

Flat Rate Service provides the residence and business customers with an unlimited number of outgoing calls within the specified local calling area of the serving exchange. Foreign exchange service is not available.

Each Flat Rate Service has the following characteristics:

Terminal Interface: 2-wire
Signaling Type: Loop Start
Pulse Type: Dual Tone Multi-Frequency (DTMF) or Dial Pulse (DP)
Directionality: Two-way

Flat Rate Basic Line Service is provided for connection of Customer-provided single-line terminal equipment such as station sets or facsimile machines.

B. Rates and Charges

In certain circumstances, service to Customers may require the use of a link (and, or) number portability arrangements provided by the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier. In such circumstances, the monthly recurring charge to the Customer will be the greater of the Company's Base Service Line charge set forth below or the charge to the Company by the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier for the link used to serve the Customer. If the Customer is served through a Number Portability Arrangement, the monthly charge to the Customer will be increased by the applicable charge from the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier to the Company of the Number Portability arrangement.

5.4 Lifeline Assistance Programs

5.4.1 Federal Lifeline Assistance Program

A. Description

The Federal Lifeline Program assists qualified low-income applicants with reductions in their monthly Local Exchange Service rate. The assistance applies to a single telephone line or broadband service, or a bundle of broadband and single telephone line service at the applicant's principal place of residence.

B. Eligibility Requirements

To receive assistance an applicant must demonstrate an annual household income at or below 135 percent of the federal poverty guidelines, or must demonstrate participation by the applicant, applicant's dependent(s) or a member of applicant's household ^[1] in one of the following programs:

- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA) or Section 8
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Veterans Pension benefit and Survivors Pension

C. Terms and Conditions

1. An applicant may request Lifeline assistance directly through the on-line consumer portal of the National Lifeline Eligibility Verifier (NLEV), also known as National Verifier. Applicants may also mail a completed paper application, Household Worksheet, and proof of eligibility to the Lifeline Support Center. Applicants may contact the Company to request that paper copies of the application and Household Worksheet be mailed to them or may obtain the required forms from the following website:

2. The Federal Lifeline Program credit may be applied to any qualifying residential Local Exchange Service provided by the Company (including Packaged Services).
3. Customers are limited to one credit per household, which may be applied towards a qualifying wireline service, a qualifying broadband service or a qualifying bundled voice and data service package. Customers are not eligible to receive a credit from the Company if they receive a Federal Lifeline Program credit for a service provided by another Eligible Telecommunications Carrier or Lifeline Broadband Provider.
4. The Federal Lifeline Program credit will begin with the first billing date after the Company is notified by applicants who qualify for benefits or when new service is established by a qualifying customer.
5. Applicants must provide proof of eligibility and be deemed eligible for participation before monthly credits begin. Credits will only be issued on a go-forward basis.
6. Nonrecurring charges will not apply when establishing this program on existing service.
7. Partial payments made by Lifeline customers will be applied first towards local service charges.
8. The discount shall be applied first to the subscriber line charge, and then to the monthly service rate for Lifeline eligible services.
9. At no time shall the total Lifeline discount exceed the sum of the subscriber line charge and the monthly service rate, excluding applicable taxes, fees, and other surcharges.
10. All Lifeline recipients will be required to recertify their eligibility every year.

11. Toll and Casual Dialing Restriction (also known as Toll Blocking) is available to Lifeline customers upon request at no charge. No service deposit will be required for applicants who voluntarily elect toll restriction with the initiation of Lifeline service.

Any Lifeline customer who has a past due balance in toll message charges will be automatically restricted from access to toll services until the outstanding balance is paid. The customer will not be charged for the toll restriction placed on the account. The Restoration Charge applies to Lifeline customers whose message toll service has been restricted for nonpayment.

If a Lifeline customer is toll restricted for a second occurrence, the Company may, at its discretion, place the Lifeline customer on a permanent toll restriction. A Lifeline subscriber's request for reconnection or re-establishment of local service will not be denied if the service was previously suspended or disconnected for non-payment of toll charges.

8.1 Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) Service

A. Description

Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) Service allows the Company to provision and restore the customer's National Security/Emergency Preparedness (NS/EP) Telecommunications Services with TSP Authorization Codes before services without such assignments as set forth in 47 CFR Part 64, Appendix A. TSP Service is available on Company services that have a unique and identifiable circuit identification number. The service is provided on a per circuit basis and includes On-Net and Leased Local Access. The underlying NS/EP Telecommunications Service is offered pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, Service Exhibit, and/or Services Schedule applicable to the service. TSP Service is only available to federal, state and local government users and certain private sector organizations that have services that support an NS/EP function.

B. Conditions

1. The customer must provide the TSP Authorization Code before the Company shall provide service.
2. The Company will not accept TSP assignments or orders without an assigned TSP Authorization Code.
3. TSP restoration priorities must be requested and assigned before a service outage occurs

C. Special Construction

If the customer requires special construction of any kind associated with the TSP, they will be charged a one-time special construction charge determined at the time of such special construction.

8.2.1 Enhanced Emergency Number Service (E911)

- A. Enhanced Emergency Number Service (E911) allows Customers to reach appropriate emergency services including police, fire and medical services. Enhanced 911 has the ability to selectively route an emergency call to the primary E911 provider so that it reaches the correct emergency service located closest to the caller. In addition, the Customer's address and telephone information will be displayed to the primary E911 provider for display at the Public Service Answering Point (PSAP).
- B. This service is offered solely as an aid in handling assistance calls in connection with fire, police and other emergencies. The Company is not responsible for any losses, claims, demands, suits or any liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted or asserted by the Customer or by any other party or person for any personal injury to or death of any person or persons, and for any loss, damage or destruction of any property, whether owned by the Customer or others, caused or claimed to have been caused by: (1) mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or other defects in the provision of this service, or (2) installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, removal, presence, condition, location or use of any equipment and facilities furnishing this service.
- C. Neither is the Company responsible for any infringement or invasion of the right of privacy of any person or persons, caused or claimed to have been caused, directly or indirectly, by the installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, removal, presence, condition, occasion or use of enhanced 911 service features and the equipment associated therewith, or by any services furnished by the Company including, but not limited to, the identification of the telephone number, address or name associated with the telephone used by the party or parties accessing enhanced 911 service, and which arise out of the negligence or other wrongful act of the Company, the Customer, its Users, agencies or municipalities, or the employees or agents of any one of them.
- D. The Company's switched network services enable the Customer to access E911 Emergency Service.

Host Telephone Company - the service provider, which is also the telecommunications public utility, that provides 9-1-1 service to the county/municipality and that houses the Automatic Location Identification (ALI)/MSAG data used for providing 9-1-1 service.

Formatting, Format - changes to the identity of fields, order of fields, and number and arrangement of data elements in each field, and a telephone company's rearrangement or regrouping of such data, without changing the MSAG content, for purposes of validating against MSAG records.

F. Regulations

The Company will comply with the Protocols, as set forth in, and in the form of, Service Provider E-9-1-1 Protocols, Service Provider E-9-1-1 Questionnaire and Testing Procedures in accordance with the Petition of Bell Atlantic-Pennsylvania, Inc. for a Declaratory Order (MSAG); Docket No. P-00971203; Settlement Agreement of all Parties and Joint Petition entered August 7, 1998.

The Company is indemnified under the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act, Act 78 of 1990.

The Company's liability is fully stated in B. and C., above, and in Section 2, General Regulations.

Cases of service interruptions affecting public health and safety shall receive priority attention under any and all conditions, particularly in time of disaster. Every appropriate resource will be utilized. The Company will make reasonable best efforts to have its system fully functional as soon as possible, unless conditions beyond the Company's control prevent service restoration.

The Host Telephone Company will install the county's/municipality's MSAG in read/write format and will not modify the content of the MSAG, unless requested or permitted to do so by the county/municipality. A request to modify content by the Host Telephone Company shall be responded to by the county/municipality within ten (10) business days or the request is deemed to be approved. The request shall be in writing and shall set forth, in reasonable detail, the proposed modification and all reasons in support. The request shall be granted provided the modification is necessary for the Host Telephone Company's provision, maintenance, or upgrading of the 9-1-1 service.
