Dear Ms. Burge:

On November 1, 2022, Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (the Company) filed Supplement No. 1 to Tariff Storm Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 to become effective on November 2, 2022. Supplement No. 1 was filed pursuant to the final Order entered August 25, 2022 in the above-captioned matter regarding PWSA's Stage 2 Compliance Plan: Stormwater. This Compliance Tariff adds line extension provisions pursuant to the June 9, 2022 Joint Petition for Settlement in this proceeding, which was subsequently approved by the August 25, 2022 Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 1 to Tariff Storm Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
