Application of Guilford Township for approval to abolish the public at-grade crossing (DOT 535 152 B) where South Third Street (T-559) crosses the single track of Norfolk Southern Railway Company in Guilford Township, Franklin County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated September 19, 2022, we approved the application for the abolition of the public at-grade crossing (DOT 535 152 B) where South Third Street (T-559) crosses the single track of Norfolk Southern Railway Company in Guilford Township, Franklin County. All work at the subject crossing was to be completed on or before December 31, 2023.

By petition received on December 29, 2023, Guilford Township requests the Commission grant an extension of time in which to complete the project until April 30, 2024. Guilford Township avers that they were unable to complete the work due to unanticipated survey work that has not been completed for the dedication and opening of the relief road.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Guilford Township's petition for an extension of time to April 30, 2024.

THEREFORE:

The petition received December 29, 2023, from Guilford Township be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 14 of our Secretarial Letter dated September 19, 2022, which reads as follows, to wit:

“14. All work required to abolish the crossing be completed on or before December 31, 2023, and that on or before said date Guilford Township, report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with this Secretarial Letter.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

14. All work required to abolish the crossing be completed on or before April 30, 2024, and that on or before said date Guilford Township, report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with this Secretarial Letter

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated September 19, 2022, remains in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
