- 4. The Complainant is authorized and directed by the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 399.50, to represent the interests of small business consumers of utility services in matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission").
- This Complaint is filed against the rates, terms, and other provisions of Original Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 48, which was filed on December 29, 2023, by Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC ("Peoples NG" or the "Company"). Peoples NG consists of two divisions Peoples Natural Gas Division and Peoples Gas Division. The proposed Original Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 48, if approved by the Commission, would result in an overall revenue increase for Peoples NG of approximately \$156.0 million per year. In addition, the December 29th filing included a proposed Weather Normalization Adjustment ("WNA"), which supposedly reflects "normalized weather conditions." After preliminary review of the materials filed by the Company in support of the proposed Original Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 48, Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that those materials may be insufficient to justify the rate increase requested and that the Company's present and proposed rates, rules, and conditions of service may be unjust, unreasonable, unduly discriminatory, and otherwise contrary to law, particularly as they pertain to small business customers.

Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that the Company's proposed rates, rate design, proposed WNA, and cost and revenue allocation are or may be unjust, unreasonable, and unlawfully discriminatory in violation of, inter alia, Sections 1301 and 1304 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1301 and 1304, and contrary to appropriate public policy and sound ratemaking considerations, and may not be supported by the materials filed by Peoples NG.

7. In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate respectfully requests that

the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

a. Suspend and investigate the operation of Original Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C.

No. 48;

b. At the conclusion of such investigation, reject the proposed new rates and

other tariff changes in Original Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 48 to the extent

required to ensure that Peoples NG's rates are lawful, just, reasonable, and

not unduly discriminatory; and

c. Grant such other relief as may be necessary or appropriate.

### PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the "Act"). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by her initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a complaint against the proposed approximately \$156.0 million general rate increase filing of Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC ("Peoples NG" or the "Company"). Peoples NG's filing also included a proposed "Weather Normalization Adjustment" ("WNA"), which the Commission has observed benefits the Company, rather than ratepayers.

The Small Business Advocate files this formal complaint against the Company's proposed general rate increase in order to protect the interests of the Company's small business customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all of the elements of the Company's

proposed general rate increase is necessary to ensure that the increase is lawful, just, reasonable,

and not unduly discriminatory.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings

before the Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed general rate increase as

well as the WNA. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny any proposed

new rates and other tariff changes that apply to small business customers that are not proven by

Peoples NG to be lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory to the Company's small

business customers.
