On April 26, 2024, the Public Utility Commission (PUC) delivered the Revised Final-Form Rulemaking Order (RFFRO) in the captioned matter to the majority and minority chairs of the Senate Committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure and the majority and minority chairs of the House Consumer Protection, Technology and Utilities Committee (collectively, Legislative Committees) and to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC).¹ The cover letters that accompanied the deliveries specified that the PUC would notify interested parties of the RFFRO submission.
