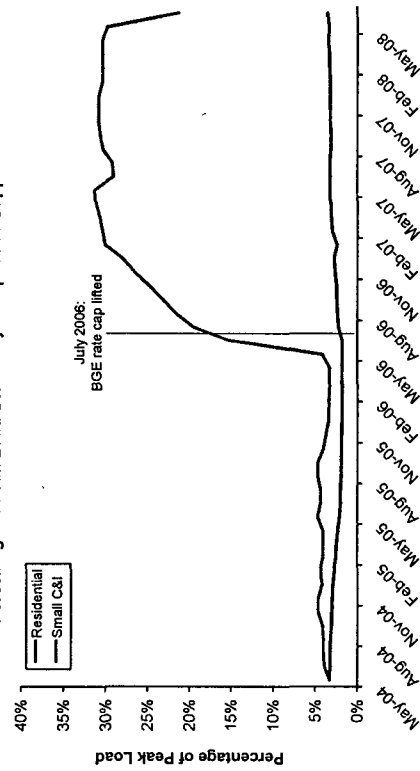


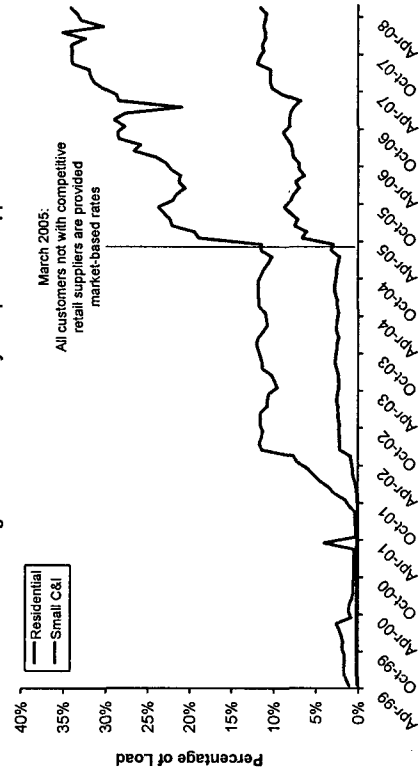

Percentage of Peak Load Served By Competitive Suppliers



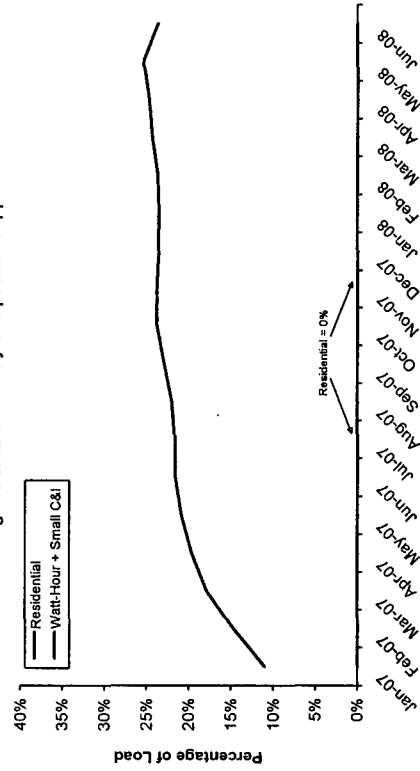
