

## Amendment to Wireline Interconnection Agreement

Commonwealth Telephone Company, an incumbent local exchange carrier (“CTCo”), and Service Electric Telephone Company, LLC, a competitive local exchange carrier (“Service Electric” or “CLEC”), hereby agree this ~~12<sup>th</sup>~~<sup>11<sup>th</sup></sup> day of ~~March~~<sup>May</sup>, 2006 to amend their Wireline Interconnection Agreement, which became effective on April 1, 2004, as follows:

1. Section 1.18, entitled “Information Access Traffic”, is deleted and replaced by the following:

1.18 "Information Access Traffic" - Information Access Traffic, for the purpose of this Agreement, is traffic (excluding CMRS traffic) that is transmitted to or returned from the Internet at any point during the duration of the transmission between the Parties. Information Access Traffic is not Local Traffic unless the traffic is between an end-user and an ISP physically located in the same CTCO Local Calling Area. The term Information Access Traffic does not include transmission of voice telecommunications traffic regardless of whether it is delivered to an ISP and regardless of whether it is carried at any point on facilities via Internet protocol.

2. Section 1.23, entitled “Local Traffic,” is deleted and replaced by the following:



1.23 "Local Traffic" - Local Traffic is traffic (excluding CMRS traffic) that is originated and terminated within the CTCO Local Calling Area, or mandatory Extended Area Service (EAS) area, as defined in CTCO's local exchange tariffs. Local Traffic does not include optional local calling (i.e., optional rate packages that permit the end-user to choose a Local Calling Area beyond the basic exchange serving area for an additional fee), referred to hereafter as “optional EAS”. Local Traffic includes Information Access Traffic to the extent that the end user and the ISP are physically located in the same CTCO Local Calling Area.

3. Section 8.10, entitled “CLEC directories,” is deleted and replaced by the following:

8.10 “CLEC Directories”. If CLEC elects to publish its own directories during the term of this Agreement, CTCO shall provide CLEC the customer listings of CTCO to be included in the CLEC directories in accordance with the FCC’s rules regarding the provision of subscriber list information , 47 CFR Sec. 64.2301 through 64.2345.

4. This Amendment shall take effect immediately upon execution of this Amendment by the parties, but shall be submitted by Commonwealth with Service Electric's support to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for review and approval pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Sec. 252(e).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have caused this AMENDMENT TO WIRELINE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT be executed as of the date set forth above.
