

**AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

**THIS AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT** (the "Amendment") is made, entered into, and effective this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July 2007, by and between Sprint Communications Company L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, and Palmerton Telephone Company (collectively, the "Parties").

**RECITALS:**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to amend their existing interconnection agreement that was submitted to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") for approval on June 13, 2007 and filed at Docket No. A-310183F7011 (the "Agreement");

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the provisions set forth below, it is agreed between the Parties that the Agreement shall be amended as follows.

**AMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENT:**


1. The following Section 25 will be added:

"25. 911/E911.

The Parties affirm and acknowledge that each Party has independently arranged direct interconnection and administrative arrangements with the relevant 911/E911 Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) for the provision of 911/E911 to users of its respective Telephone Exchange Services. As such, the Parties do not require any interconnection or other arrangements between themselves for purposes of 911/E911".




