On 9/23/09, Core Communications, Inc. (Core) filed a Formal Complaint (Complaint) against XO Communications Services, Inc. (XO) regarding compensation for the termination by Core of Internet Service Provider (ISP)-bound traffic. After an evidentiary hearing, ALJ Melillo issued an Initial Decision on 5/18/12, that dismissed the Complaint, in part, and sustained it, in part. The Parties filed Exceptions on 6/7/12 and Replies to Exceptions on 6/18/12. On 11/23/16, the Commission entered an Opinion and Order (November 2016 Order) that granted, in part, and denied, in part, each of the Parties' Exceptions. In addition, the Commission, *inter alia*, directed Core to issue a revised invoice to XO consistent with the terms set forth in the November 2016 Order and required Core to comply with the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Transformation Order and the Commission's continuous implementation of the FCC's Transformation Order at Docket No. M-2012-2291824. On 12/9/16, Core filed a Petition for Reconsideration/Clarification (Petition) of the November 2016 Order. XO filed an Answer to the Petition on 12/20/16.

On 5/13/21, the Parties submitted a Settlement Agreement (Settlement) and Statements in Support of the Settlement. The Settlement proposes a \$59,750 civil penalty and corrective measures.
