Supplement No. 343 to Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 (Supplement No. 343) at Docket No. R-2022-3032167 filed on 4/26/22, with an effective date of 1/1/23. Supplement No. 343 proposed the implementation of a five-year pilot program, called the Green Path Rider (GPR), that was alleged to allow customers an option to reduce some or all of their emissions related to their natural gas usage. On 3/22/23, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (Columbia), the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (BIE), and the Office of Small Business Advocate (OSBA) filed a Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement and Statements in Support of the Settlement. Penn State University (PSU) indicated that it did not oppose the Settlement. On 3/29/23, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) and the Retail Energy Supply Association, Shipley Choice, LLC d/b/a Shipley Energy and NRG Energy, Inc. (collectively, RESA/NGS) each filed Comments opposing the Settlement. Also, on 3/29/23, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed a Letter in opposition to the Settlement. On 4/19/23, the Recommended Decision of DCALJ Pell and ALJ Coogan, was issued. On 4/26/23, the OCA and the RESA/NGS Parties filed Exceptions. On 5/1/23, Columbia filed Replies to Exceptions.
