NAME AND SUBJECT: PA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION ET AL VS PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS

On 2/28/20, Supplement No. 128 to PGW's Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 and Supplement No. 85 to PGW's Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 was filed, to become effective 11/28/20, containing proposed changes to base rates designed to produce a net increase in PGW's annual distribution revenue of approximately \$70 million, or 10.5%, above existing distribution revenues. Upon the filing of various Formal Complaints, the matter was suspended by operation of law until 11/28/20 and assigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge. Subsequently, PGW voluntarily agreed to extend the statutory suspension period until 12/4/20. On 5/12/20, PGW filed Tariff Supplements reflecting the voluntary extension. On 8/26/20, a Joint Petition for Partial Settlement was filed, with several issues reserved for briefing. On 10/5/20, the Recommended Decision of ALJ Heep and ALJ Guhl, was issued recommending approval of the Partial Settlement, with modifications. Exceptions were filed on 10/15/20 and Replies to Exceptions were filed on 10/20/20.
