


WPPSEF Focus

Mission elements

- Promote use of renewable and clean energy technologies
- Promote energy conservation & efficiency
- Promote education, economic development, and environmental benefit of renewable/ clean energy use and energy conservation/ efficiency (three E's)



2020 Review (Q1 | pre-shutdown)

- Going into 2020
 - 10 loans (\$4.1M), 19 grants (\$785k) as of 01/31/20
 - Kane Passive House entering design phase

- 2020 RFP closed on 01/29/20
 - 19 requests, 14 approved (\$410k) on 02/21/20

Entering March – robust activity

2020 In Review (Q2 | shutdown)

- Impact of COVID-19 pandemic
 - PA shutdown 03/21, reopening begins 05/01
 - Impacted WPPSEF activities
 - Remote operations, online communications, cloud data sharing, disruption of projects, limitations on travel, supply chain disruptions, price volatility, loan payment deferrals
 - Kane Passive House initial design completed mid-June 2020, building permit obtained

2020 In Review (Q3 | Q4)

- Kane Passive House construction underway
- Working with projects to determine how pandemic impacted their progress
 - Leg Up Farms
 - Nixon-Kocher Drinking Water Plant
 - Fairchance Senior Housing
 - ReFarm Café at Windswept Farm

2020 Project Management Summary

Going into 2020

- 10 loans (\$4.1M)
- 19 grants (\$785,000)
- Kane Passive House early design phase

End of 2020

- 7 loans (\$3.96M)
- 11 grants (\$372,492)
- Kane Passive House active construction phase

- Education workforce development/ community outreach




Uptown Kane – Roof Views
