Customer Education and Outreach Plan (CEOP) – 2023¹

Background: PECO's Low-Income Programs

PECO has a comprehensive, complementary suite of low-income programs designed to help provide energy security for low-income households. PECO's programs address bill payment assistance, utility and government grant programs, usage reduction, and situational assistance.

PECO's Customer Assistance Program (**CAP**) is available for households at or below 150% FPL (*Federal Poverty Level*). PECO's CAP was changed from a CAP FCO (*Fixed Credit Option*) to a CAP-PIPP (*Percentage of Income Payment Plan*) in December 2022. Customers enrolled in a CAP-PIPP pay a percentage of their income as their PECO bill (up to an annual maximum) or their actual monthly usage, whichever is less.²

In addition to ongoing bill payment assistance via CAP, PECO provides usage reduction services via its Low-Income Usage Reduction Program – **LIURP**. LIURP is designed to complement CAP by providing usage reduction education and, if eligible, remediation measures to decrease the amount of energy used, thereby reducing bills and increasing affordability. LIURP income eligibility is 200% FPL or below.

PECO also has a hardship program – Matching Energy Assistance Fund (**MEAF**) – that provides customers at or below 200% FPL whose service is in threat of termination or has been terminated for non-payment with a grant to cure arrears and bring the balance to zero – thereby creating a fresh start.

PECO provides support for customers who seek a Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (**LIHEAP**) grant. PECO provides the LIHEAP application in English and Spanish on our website and a LIHEAP hotline to assist customers with LIHEAP questions. The Company also serves as a liaison between the customer and DHS (Department of Human Services).

PECO has a Customer Assistance Referral and Evaluation Service (**CARES**) team that provides referral and information services to assist special-needs, low-income customers who have financial hardships.

² Note that there are also minimum bill requirements for Electric Non-Heating (Rate R) - \$10 and Electric Heating (Rate RH) and Gas - \$20.

PECO's Community Engagement Team:

PECO's Community Engagement (CE) team was launched in the first quarter of 2019. CE is responsible for Outreach and Education regarding the core programs that serve our low-income customers. CE is also responsible for engaging community partners and service providers who support low-income communities.

The primary purpose of PECO's CE team is to increase:

- **Awareness**
- **Access**
- **Enrollment**

Each of the three pillars above builds off the preceding pillar.

COVID-19 Pandemic:

The COVID-19 pandemic had a significant impact on the CE team. Prior to COVID-19, the Company's focus was on engaging the low-income community through traditional, in-person outreach methods. Calendar years 2020 and 2021 presented challenges for the CE team due to COVID-19 and social distancing. Traditional, in-person outreach was no longer an option, yet the need for outreach was even more pronounced than before given the financial impacts of COVID-19.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, PECO's CE team implemented (or increased) several no-contact outreach methods including:

- Social Media
- Emails
- Direct Dial Phone Calls
- Posters with tear-offs or QR codes in high-traffic venues in low-income zip codes (e.g., food markets)
- Radio interviews (conducted in both English and Spanish)
- Virtual Enrollment Customer Sessions
- Virtual Trainings for Service Providers

Although PECO resumed in-person outreach in 2022, the Company still holds some virtual events today. A combination of access options provides greater engagement for customers and service providers alike. For example, PECO continues to conduct trainings for service providers both virtually and in-person (based on the agencies' preferences). Additionally, virtual enrollment sessions are a customer satisfier and have received support from the Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS).

Awareness:

As was noted above, awareness is the first building block of PECO's outreach strategy. For this reason, PECO conducts a variety of outreach events/efforts throughout our service territory every year. Outreach locations are strategically selected and come from a variety of sources. PECO also uses external agencies to advance awareness.

External Relationships/Community Partners:

In calendar year 2019, PECO entered into paid relationships with twenty-three (23) Community Based Organizations (CBOs) to become "CAP Enrollment Sites". These organizations, strategically located throughout PECO's service territory, are trusted entities in low-income communities.

PECO is always looking to expand our partnerships with external organizations, and to that end, PECO has since onboarded seven (7) additional organizations as CAP enrollment sites, bringing the current total of PECO CAP Enrollment Sites to thirty (30). The list of PECO's CAP enrollment sites is included as **Attachment A**.

In addition to onboarding CAP Enrollment Sites, PECO expanded its relationships with other specialized organizations that support various vulnerable low-income populations as well, including veterans' organizations, organizations that support victims of domestic abuse, hospital systems and the Philadelphia District Attorney's office.

PECO provided trainings and created a process whereby these organizations can formally refer their clients to us. This new referral process expands PECO's reach to these vulnerable populations.

Trainings for the aforementioned organizations included information on Energy Burden – what it is, how it is calculated, and how it affects energy costs. Outreach presentations for customers also include information on Energy Burden and usage reduction tips to help lower energy costs.

Outreach Location Selection Strategy:

PECO receives numerous outreach requests annually from various entities (e.g., CBOs, elected officials' offices, public schools). PECO considers Census and PECO customer zip code data when selecting and/or soliciting Outreach event locations. Specifically, PECO targets the following for Outreach locations:

- Low-income zip codes: 0–200% FPL
- LEP zip codes (Limited English Proficiency)
- 0-50% FPL zip codes
- Zip codes that have the highest levels of termination activity

Outreach Staffing Strategy:

Staffing for Outreach events is determined on a case-by-case basis. PECO considers the following factors in determining staffing needs for each individual Outreach event:

- Type of event – table, enrollment, or presentation event
- Number of anticipated attendees
- LEP areas – For Spanish speaking zip codes, PECO makes every attempt to staff those events with Spanish speaking resources (employees and/or contractors). For non-Spanish speaking LEP areas, PECO works with event organizers and/or community partners to solicit interpreters who speak the language requested, to attend the event and assist with interpretation needs.
- Location of the event – The safety of our employees and contractors is a top priority – to that end, a minimum of 2 resources are allocated for certain areas

Enhancements in Outreach since 2019:

- **Low Income Simulations:**
 - A 4-hour simulation exercise designed to help participants better understand the challenges and lived experiences of low-income individuals.
 - The purpose is to engage in a shared experience that illustrates structural barriers, as well as the personal and emotional challenges people in poverty face every day.
- **Virtual Enrollment Sessions:**
 - In 2022 the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) introduced virtual Utility Fairs in which PECO and the Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) participated. In 2023, PECO started hosting its own Virtual Enrollment sessions where customers are provided a variety of services based on their specific needs, including enrollment in CAP, payment agreements, and LIHEAP assistance.
 - For the PECO-led Virtual Enrollment sessions, PECO identifies customer segments who could benefit from these sessions (e.g., customers on CAP but not LIHEAP), and solicits their participation via email. PECO also uses targeted social media. There are a total of 120 slots available each session, and for each session, all slots are filled. While typically only one-third of registrants attend, all registrants are contacted either before or after the event by a Community Engagement team member.
- **Collaborations** with agencies that support low-income communities with a variety of utility and non-utility assistance options. PECO recognizes that low-income customers may need assistance with items other than their utilities. To that end, PECO has partnered with the two (2) organizations listed below to provide more of these types of services:
 - **Findhelp.org** – Findhelp.org is a national, online assistance finder portal that provides information and links to a variety of free or low-cost assistance needs (e.g., pharmacy assistance, food pantries). PECO promotes Findhelp.org on its website.
 - **BDT (Benefits Data Trust)** – In 2023 PECO paired with BDT, a non-profit that helps facilitate enrollment in various governmental assistance programs (e.g., SNAP, Medicaid). PECO is in the process of sending information about BDT and the services they provide to its CAP customers who have given an email address to PECO.

- **Poverty Summit** – In October 2022, PECO hosted its first Poverty Summit at our Main Office Building. The Summit was both in-person and virtual, with approximately 100 participants – consisting primarily of social service agencies – attending in-person. The Summit featured a facilitated dialogue with four thought leaders on the following topics:
 - Crisis of poverty across our region
 - Impact of poverty on housing, education, women & children, employment and more
 - Racial and economic disparities that impede the transition out of poverty
 - Opportunities and strategies to assist vulnerable populations

Access:

The second outreach pillar is Access. A variety of methods exist to access PECO’s assistance programs. PECO understands that customers have different engagement tolerances and preferences. While PECO maintains simple online enrollment options, the Company recognizes that some customers are either uncomfortable with online enrollment or lack the tools necessary for online enrollment. For this reason, PECO continues to offer a variety of enrollment options, including³:

- Online/website
- U.S. Mail
- Email
- Fax
- Community Partners
- In-person Outreach Events
- Virtual Outreach Events

0-50% FPL Outreach:

PECO submitted its 0-50% FPL Outreach Plan in 2022. This document was filed originally in February 2022 and then re-filed in June 2022 as an amendment to PECO’s USECP filing.⁴

Income eligibility for PECO’s CAP, is 0-150% FPL (Federal Poverty Level). That number is broken down into 3 tiers (0-50% FPL; 51-100% FPL; and 101-150% FPL). 0-50% FPL is considered the lowest tier and is also referred to as the “poorest of the poor”. Historically, this has also been the hardest customer group to reach.

PECO recognizes there are unique challenges with this customer segment and has increased its targeted outreach to this customer population.

PECO engages CAP Enrollment Sites to support 0-50% FPL customers with CAP enrollment as well as other services (e.g., LIHEAP assistance). A list of those agencies can be found in **Attachment A** to this document.

PECO's target for 0-50% FPL customers for the next 5 years (2022 – 2026 inclusive), is a 5% increase in total enrollment of customers at or below 50% FPL over 2019 (pre-COVID). As total enrollment is a product of both new enrollment and recertification retentions, PECO will focus on both new enrollees as well as recertification retentions for the 0-50% FPL population.

The actuals for 0–50% FPL for calendar year 2022 are as follows:

LEP – Limited English Proficiency:

PECO conducted analysis using government data (Census/ACS), to determine dominant languages in our service territory. PECO defines a dominant language as one spoken by 5% or more of the residents in our service territory. Spanish is the only language that hits that 5% threshold (Chinese is second, at 3% of our service territory).

PECO provides certain documents, including the Universal Services' Low-Income brochure, CAP application, no-income form, LIHEAP application, and "New Customer Handbook" in English and Spanish.

PECO also provides language assistance to our LEP customer base via a variety of other methods including:

- LEP assistance via Language Line for up to 128 different languages
- Portions of PECO's website are translated into Spanish and Simplified Chinese
- LEP community organizations onboarded as PECO CAP enrollment sites
- Spanish-speaking staff at PECO virtual enrollment sessions
- Outreach presentations in Spanish for Spanish-dominant zip codes
- Radio interviews and advertising in English and Spanish

Enrollment:

The final pillar of PECO's outreach plan is enrollment. Enrollment of customers that are new to CAP is one measure of the success of the Company's outreach efforts. To that end, annual projections are shown for the following:

The positive trend in the last column demonstrates the success of PECO's outreach efforts as in 2022, PECO exceeded its CAP new enrollment projections.

Other Outreach Metrics:

In addition, PECO has other measures of success related to its low-income outreach, specifically:

- LIHEAP Dollars
- Outreach Events
- Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Outreach Events

In calendar year 2022, Community Engagement completed 284 Outreach events. The Outreach event projection for 2022 was 235 events. Any given year can present more, or fewer Outreach opportunities based on outside organization events.

Below represents outreach efforts in calendar year 2022 by category:

Total number of events: 284

Total number of in-person events: 238

Total number of Virtual events: 46

Total number of Radio events – virtual only: 4

Total number of Radio events – virtual and In-person: 18

Total number of LEP events: 30

Total number of 0-50% events: 149

Total number of Philadelphia events: 252

Total number of county events: 32

Total number of presentations only (i.e., Legislative Forums): 13

***LIHEAP Dollars** – Total PA LIHEAP allocation (not including CARES funding) for FY 2022 was \$195M. PECO's projection for FY 2022 was 8% of the PA state allocation or \$15.6M. PECO notes that while LIHEAP dollars for the last full LIHEAP season (FY 2022) included additional COVID funding from the federal CARES Act, the increase in regular LIHEAP dollars from FY 2022 was still significantly above projections.

****LEP** – 2022 is the first year PECO has tracked LEP events, so there were no 2022 projections. PECO will continue to track LEP efforts for 2023 and 2024 and then set targets for outer years based on actuals as well as customer needs.

For 2023 PECO's Projections are as follows:

- **LIHEAP Dollars** – 8% of the total PA LIHEAP allocation (not including CARES funding)
- **Outreach** – 235 events
- **LEP** – As previously noted, PECO will continue to track LEP events for 2023 and 2024 and establish an LEP Outreach goal for 2025 and beyond

Additional Outreach Data Collection:

In addition to the previously noted measures of success, PECO will collect data on Outreach elements in calendar year 2024 to evaluate establishing additional goals for 2025 and beyond. Those elements include:

- Outreach events:
 - Table events – number of customers to whom PECO gave information to (i.e., CAP application, LIHEAP application, brochures)
 - Enrollment events – number of customers assisted and what that assistance consisted of (i.e., CAP enrollment)
- Number of referrals received from various partners (i.e., Findhelp, Domestic Abuse organizations)
- Number of Virtual Enrollment events (i.e., number of customers signed up, number of customers assisted during the sessions)
