On June 21, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PAPUC) timely filed its Notice of Intervention at the above-captioned Case No. ER24-2172, *PJM Amended Interconnection Service Agreement (ISA), Amendment to ISA, SA No. 1442; Queue No. NQ-123 (amend)*. A Joint Protest by American Electric Power Service Corporation and Exelon Corporation was filed requesting a hearing alleging that questions of fact remain unresolved in this novel configuration that went around the PJM stakeholder process.

The PAPUC agrees that questions of fact and law remain unresolved and supports the referral of the case for hearing.
